PMeVidya 200 DTH TV Channels

On 1st February, 2022, in the budget speech, the Government of India announced 200 PMeVidya DTH TV Channels for school and teacher education. These channels aim to cater the educational needs of learners in various Indian languages and based on the curriculum of States/UTs.

PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels for school education are designed to achieve the five cardinal principles of National Education Policy 2020 viz., access, equity, quality, affordability and accountability in education.

Multi-Modal access. Curricular video are available on DIKSHA also available on DD's Free dish network

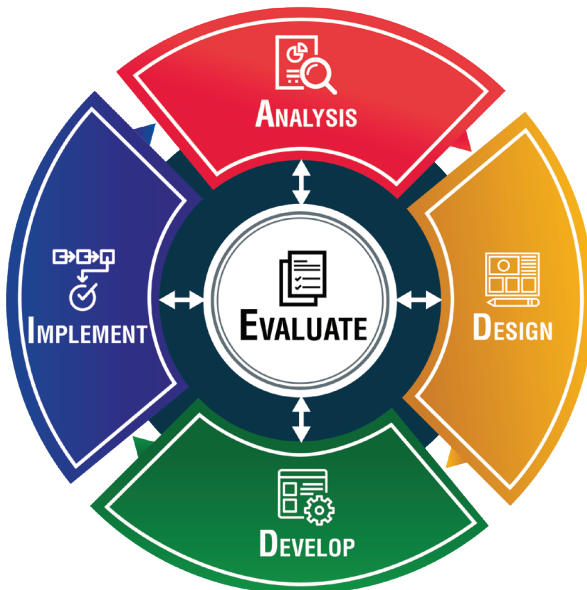
