#### Accessibility in NCERT Text books- An Overview





- Post NCF 2005, NCERT textbooks comprehensively cover the concept and issues related to accessibility for children with disabilities

- E-patshala Mobile App- "Text To Speech (TTS)" for children with Visual Impairments


## Accessibility in NCERT Text books - Examples from "Environmental Studies" Text Books- Primary Stage
