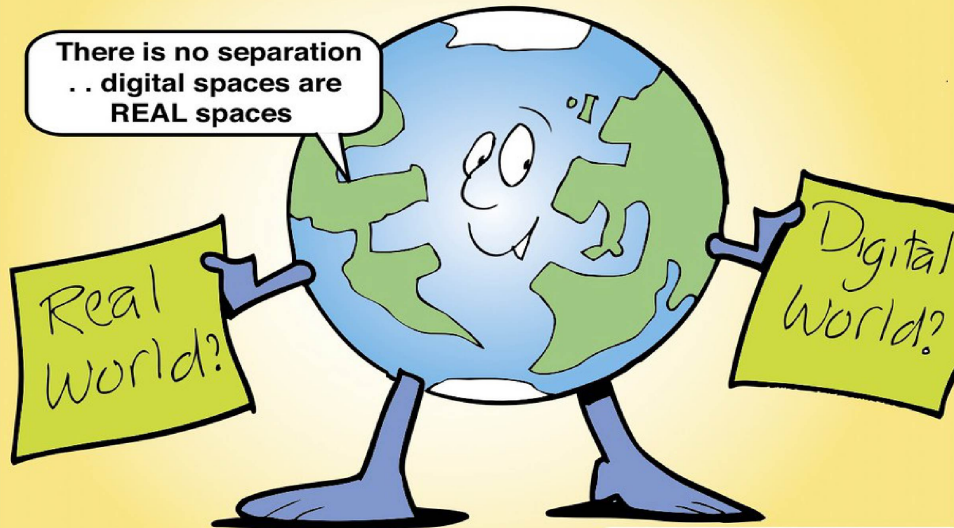

Rule 3: Know where you are in cyberspace.

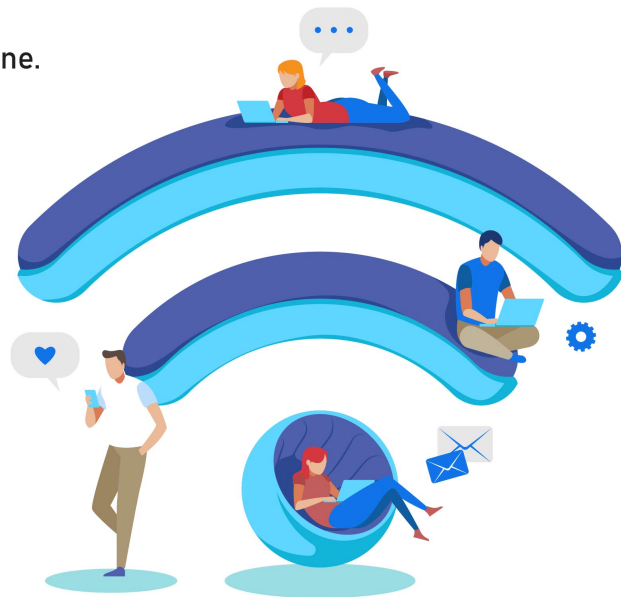
Rule 8: Maintain your privacy & respect other's privacy.

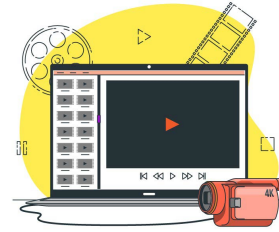
