Background

National Curriculum Framework (2005) , prepared by NCERT has highlighted the important role of **Constructivism in teaching-learning process.**

Learners actively construct their own knowledge by **connecting new ideas to existing ideas on the basis of materials/activities presented to them (experience).**

There is a **social aspect in the construction process in the sense that knowledge needed for a complex task can reside in a group situation.**


Collaborative learning provides room for negotiation of meaning, sharing of multiple views and changing the internal representation of the external reality. Construction indicates that each learner individually and socially constructs meaning as he/she learns.

“Collaborative learning is a situation in which two or more people learn or attempt to learn something together.”

Collaborative learning can occur peer-to-peer or in larger groups.

ONLINE COLLABORATIVE LEARNING

People working together online to achieve a shared goal

Online collaborative learning means participants learning together in teams using information communication technologies

Collaborative online learning is usually called “online teams” or “online groups”

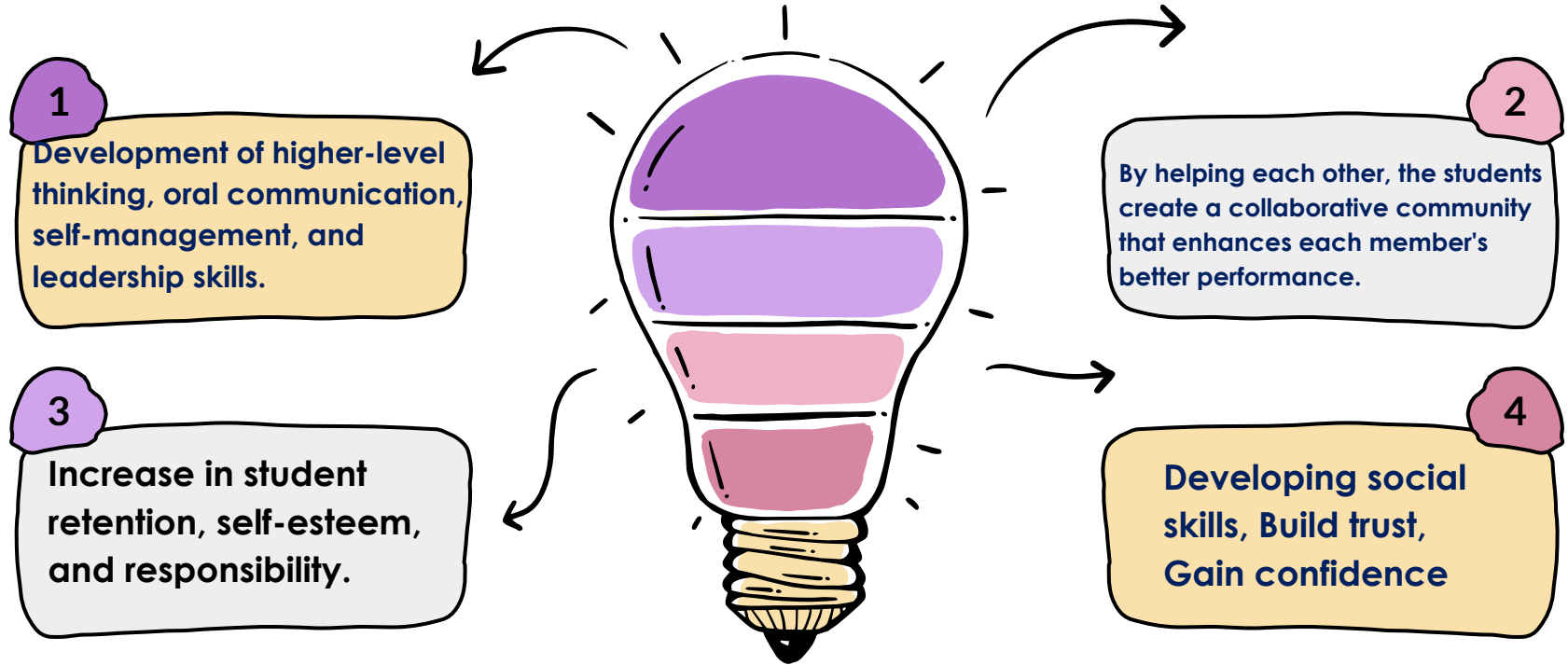
Online collaboration is defined as a group of students engaged in collaborative learning through cyber space





A blend of constructivism within the environment of the internet; provides a model of learning in which students are encouraged and supported to work together to create knowledge

To work jointly with others or together especially in an intellectual endeavor.

Investigating an issue from variety of perspectives

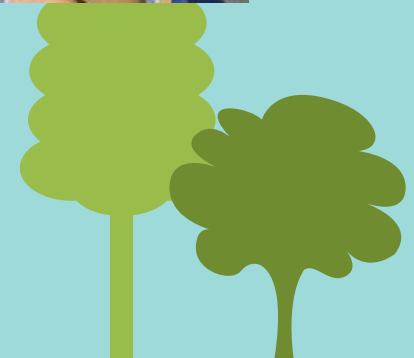
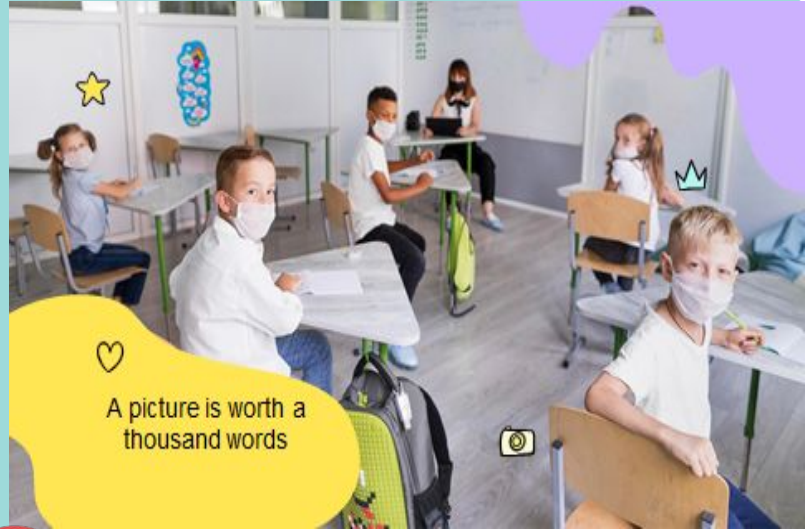
Developed by Edward de Bono, a Maltese physician, psychologist and philosopher.

- **More organized thinking.**
- **Improved creativity.**
- **Better thinking skills.**
- **Stronger interpersonal skills.**
- **Greater inclusion in teams.**

- **Looking back on or dealing with past events or situations. The general purpose is to allow the team, as a group, to evaluate its past working cycle**
- **Retrospective enable team to Improve the quality of work, Increase the efficiency, Increase the productivity and amplify learning.**

Starfish Retrospective

- ❖ **The Starfish retrospective is a technique developed by Patrick Kua**
- ❖ **Help teams reflect on varying degrees of actions and activities rather than simply the traditional what went well or what did not go well.**

Math teachers can format their IdeaBoards with up to 10 sections with each section having a different problem. Students can add ideas underneath each section for how to go about solving the problem.

Science teachers can format their IdeaBoards to have sections that match the number of steps in the water cycle. Under each step, students can write in their own words what happens in each step of the water cycle.

English/Language Arts teachers can format their IdeaBoards to include multiple sections with prompts that encourage students to explore and think about a book in unique ways.

For a social studies presentation or a presentation in an elective class, students can create a pros and cons IdeaBoard on a topic of their choice

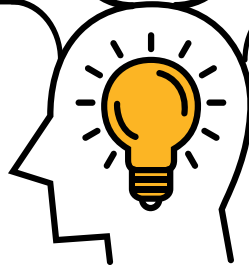
PROS

Easy to DELETE a board

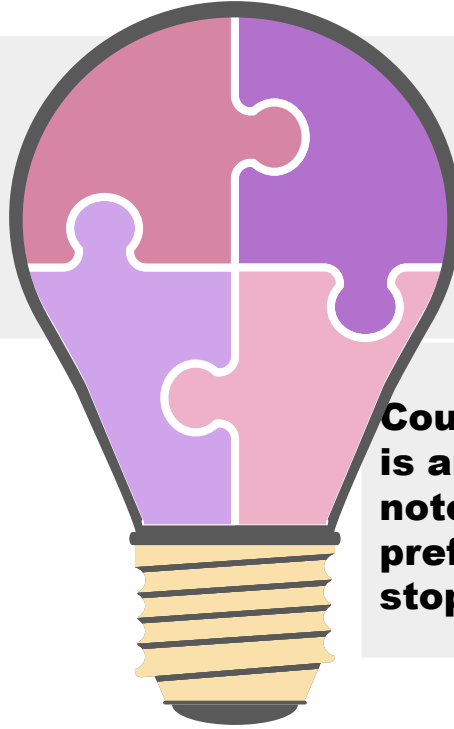
EASY to SHARE the board with others.

Could have been better if there is an option to choose Sticky notes color based on personal preference. Again, not a show stopper.

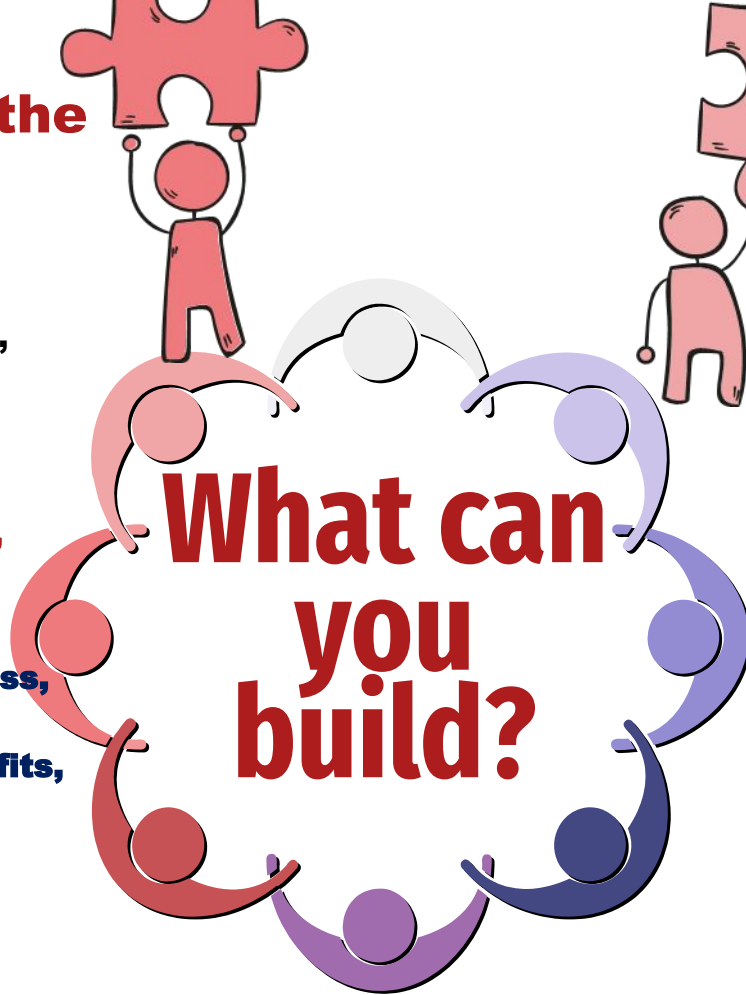
