The Directory of Open Access Repositories - OpenDOAR

<u>Search for repositories</u> | <u>Search repository contents</u> | <u>List of repositories</u> | <u>Repository Statistics</u>

*Open*DOAR is an authoritative directory of academic open access repositories. Each *Open*DOAR repository has been visited by project staff to check the information that is recorded here. This in-depth approach does not rely on automated analysis and gives a <u>quality-controlled</u> list of repositories.




As well as providing a simple <u>repository list</u>, *Open*DOAR lets you <u>search for repositories</u> or <u>search repository contents</u>. Additionally, we provide tools and support to both repository administrators and service providers in sharing best practice and improving the quality of the repository infrastructure. Further explanation of these features is given in a project document <u>Beyond the list</u>.

The current directory lists repositories and allows breakdown and selection by a variety of criteria - see the <u>Find</u> page - which can also be viewed as <u>statistical charts</u>. The underlying database has been designed from the ground up to include in-depth information on each repository that can be used for search, analysis, or underpinning services like text-mining. The *Open*DOAR service is being developed incrementally, developing the current service as new features are introduced. A list of <u>Upgrades and Additions</u> is available.

Developments will be of use both to users wishing to find original research papers and for service providers like search engines or alert services which need easy-to-use tools for developing tailored search services to suit specific user communities.

Growth of the OpenDOAR Database




Repositories by Continent


About OATD.org






Quality Assessment



Being (i) excellent, (ii) perfect, (iii) fit for purpose, (iv) cost-efficient, and/or (v) transformative. The first two dimensions are not concerned with education. 
The OER localisation processes








Evaluate Your Sources with TIPs Framework








Evaluate Your Sources with TIPs Framework




The TIPS

overall 65 criteria.


These 38 criteria are presented here as the 2014 TIPS Framework version 2.0.
