



Desktop library turns a big hit

www.librarykvpattom.wordpress.com has been hailed as the first Indian library blog

THE state of school libraries is no different from the plight of extinct animals or dying artforms. Hardly appealing and no takers. And why should they, when students can in too. read as much as they please by sitting in front of computers at home.

Then, why not take a library online and make it available to students at their desk-

tom, Thiruvananthapuram, had this idea one fine day in the September of 2007. Things have never been the same after that. The library took to web world with a blog of its own, which has been hailed as the first Indian library blog Log on to www.librarykvpat. Asha P Nair tom wordpress.com and you know why it has many takers.

The whole concept revolves around the wordpress.com to know details. idea that a library should be a friend, says the blogs and all the other web initiatives of KV Pattom. "Children spent more time before computers logging on to social networking sites. On an experimental basis, we began this library blog, which was a way of reaching out to these kids online. If they don't come to library, then let's reach them where they are," Faizal says.

The blog has everything the student might want to know about. Library services, both offline and online, library activities, library bulletin, library automation (KV Pattom is the first of KV schools in the country to go fully automated) and, of

course, on every other book that the student comes across. The response was tremendous, there is now a healthy turnout at the library, Faizal says. There are blog interactions happening, students can chat with the librarian online and send him queries about books and lots of e-mail queries are pouring

Having done that, Faizal started an emagazine for the library, libzine, which is available at www.libzine.wordpress.com. And to make students more attached to top? Faizal, the librarian at the Library books, another blog was started, www. Media Centre at Kendriya Vidyalaya Pat- mydearbook.wordpress.com. This blog is

exclusively for publishing book reviews written by students.




After a reading session at the library, students can scribble in whatever they thought about the book or about their reading experience. Another service provided by this library is the access to class homeworks and assignments

online. Log on to www.homeworksonline.

And then there is Library Junction (www. Faizal He, a qualified librarian, manages libraryjunction.ning.com), which is a social networking community, owned by this library. As the catchline says, "it's where minds meet and ideas pop up, to promote books, reading, knowledge and libraries." There are nearly 450 members in this network now and half of them are KV students. while the rest are from outside. From the forum, you get to know that almost all happenings in the book world, from plagiarism alleged against J.K. Rowling to Twilight Saga's success, are being discussed here.

A positive signal, indeed.

S L Faisal, a librarian with the Kendriya Vidyalaya, Pattom has been recognised for his contribution to national development of school libraries


e realised the possibility of digital technology and pioneered the diversification of traditional library into e-books and blogs almost a decade

ago. In recognition of his achievements, S L Faisal, a librarian with the Kendriya Vidvalava, Pattom, has now been conferred with an international recognition.

The '2016 IASL School Librarianship Award', instituted by the International Association of School Librarianship (IASL) recognised Faisal's 'contribution to the national development of school libraries and services within his own country'. The award is also a recognition of the services rendered to the school library movement internationally.

After pursuing his Masters in Library Science at Kerala University in 2003 and bagging the first rank. Faisal joined the Kendriva Vidyalaya Sangathan. He was given his first posting in strife-prone Baramulla in Jammu and Kashmir. Instead of showing reluctance in working in a troubled area. Faisal took it up as an opportunity.

"Though it was a small school, it also gave me huge opportunity to come out with many innovations in the library. In three-and-a-half years, we were able to transform the school library of KV, Baramulla, into one of the best libraries in the Valley," Faisal said, during an interaction wtih 'Thiruvananthapuram Express'

Faisal is currently pursuing his PhD at the University of Kerala and his topic of research is school libraries in India. The research will focus on how libraries have contributed towards achieving academic excellence in schools, especially in schools under the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan," he said. The librarian feels that the total transformation of books into e-books would happen eventually. "It cannot be called a book-less future. The books will only take new shape and form. We just need to be prepared for it," he says.

What Lies ahead

Innovations Galore

In 2007, Faisal came back to the canital and joined KV. Pattom. At a time when social media and micro-blogging were taking baby steps, the librarian set up a blog on wordpress www.librarykypattom.wordpress.com The school library A's blog, considered the first of its kind in India, has received more than 50 lakh hits till date.

In 2008, Faisal automated the KV Pattom library, which became the first fully automated Kendriva Vidyalaya library in India. The library has an excellent collection of online and offline resources and a variety of user services.

In 2010, Faisal launched an online academic social network, 'Library Junction', with more than 1,000 students and a group of teachers as members, with the main objective of collaborative learning and knowledge sharing.

Other innovative projects and experiments include 'Face a Book', a summer reading challenge: 'Gift a Book and Get a Friend', a social responsibility initiative; "Read my Buddy" a collaborative reading programme aimed at transforming moderate readers into fervent readers through mentoring by peers and teachers. Home Works and Assignments Online, the first online home work portal; My Dear Book, website of student's book reviews; InfoLit India, an information Literacy initiative and LibZine, an e-magazine were some of his other pioneering works.
