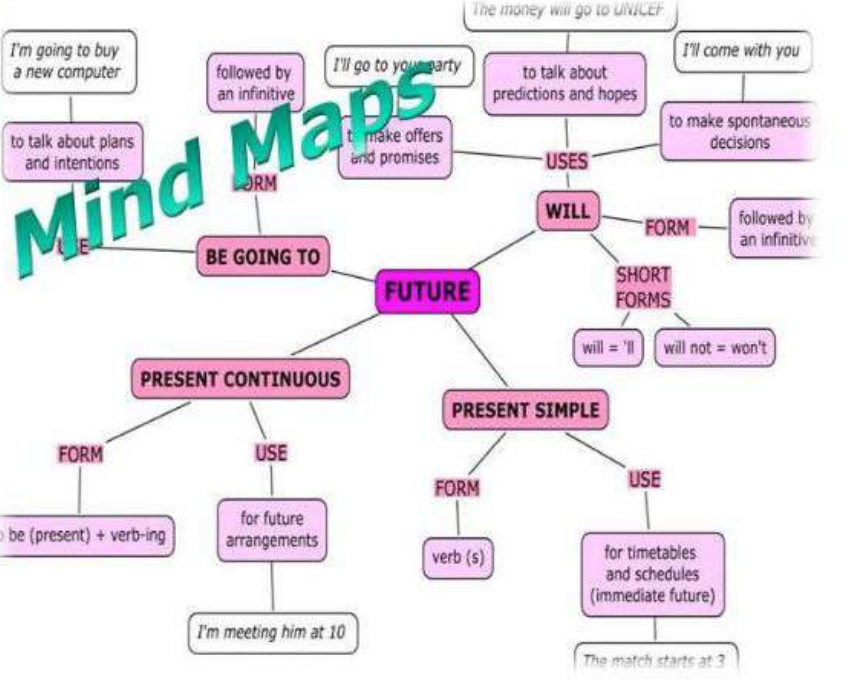



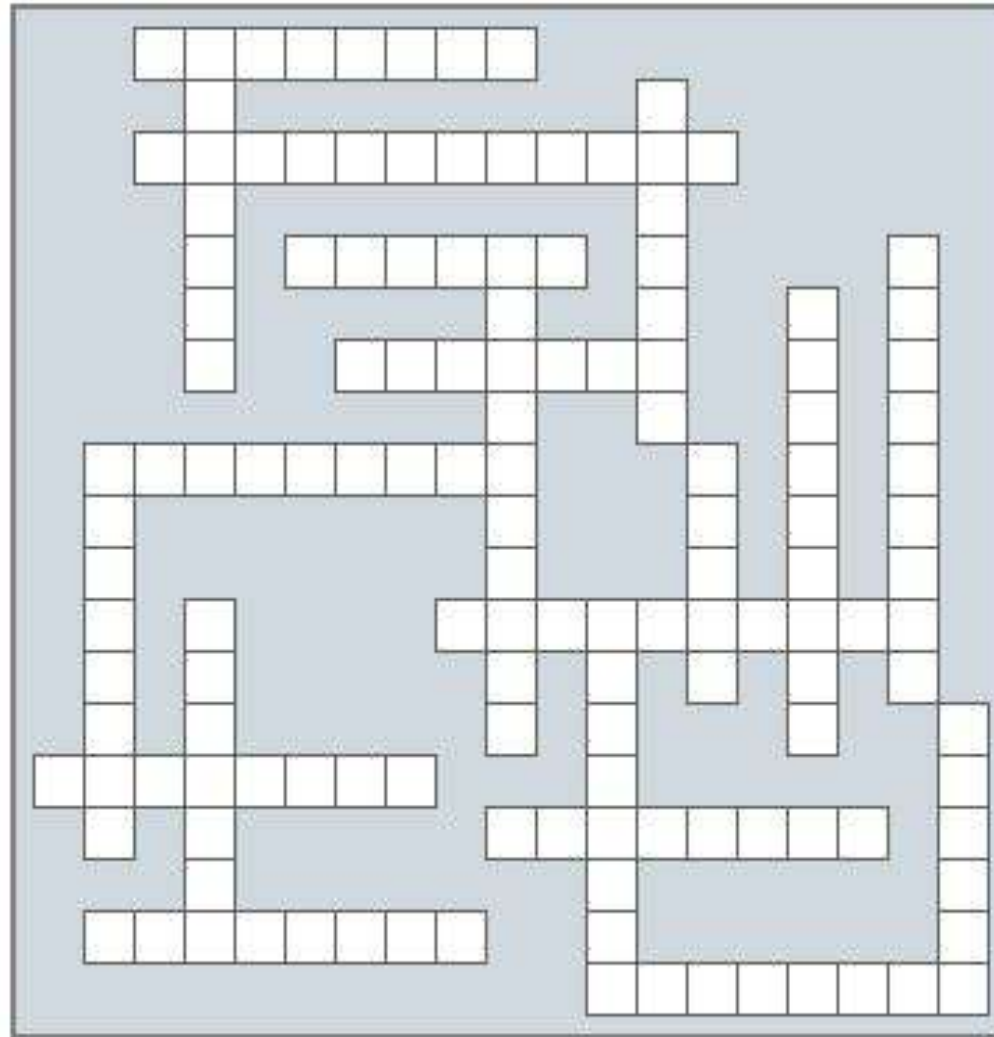
Soon after smoking tobacco, the following effects may be experienced:
