
















The broken body of Damori Miles was found on the ground outside the Albany Houses about 7 p.m. Tuesday.

Wrapped around his body was the string and plastic bag he used for the parachute, police sources said. The boy died at Interfaith Medical Center an hour later.

"It's terrible. The kids try to imitate what they see and they think they can fly," said family friend Sumore Murrel, 29.

In a recent tragic incident in Pune (The Hindu , April 2) three teenagers who tried to imitate their favourite TV serial CID ended up kidnapping and murdering a friend. This brings back memories of several such incidents when crime and violence on TV and cinema had terrible real-life consequences. A teenager in Delhi who forged his own kidnapping was influenced by a Hindi film 'Khiladi'. In Amravati, two boys influenced by another Hindi film 'Divyashakti' kidnapped a girl and drew dirty pictures on her body.

A French youth died in an explosion after he tried to imitate the hero of an American TV serial by manufacturing a bomb using easily available ingredients. In a shocking incident in San Diego, a high school student killed his parents and sister

NEW DELHI: Last month, a 90-year-old man and his 64-year-old daughter-in-law were found murdered in their Patel Nagar (East) home. The incident shocked the capital, but nobody could guess that a Bollywood thriller starring Akshay Kumar had unwittingly inspired an 18-year-old to plot the murders. He had no bone to pick with his victims; he just needed money by all means to buy a fancy cellphone he coveted.

On Wednesday, the killer teen, Deepanshu (18), was arrested from a school near Anand Parbat. And he let out the ugly truth with blood-curdling details.

Deepanshu, the son of a domestic help, was an undergraduate student at a private college in Raebareli, UP. His friends over there came from well-to-do families and had a flamboyant lifestyle. Peer pressure got to Deepanshu.







In teaching and learning processes, it equips educators with enhanced knowledge about how to critically engage with information, media, and digital technologies to empower future citizens and learners to become peer-educators of MIL

Media and information literacy imparts crucial knowledge about the functions of content providers and mediators such as libraries, archives, museums, media, and digital communications companies, reasonable understanding about the conditions needed to perform those functions effectively and critical skills required to evaluate the performance of content providers in light of the expected functions.




MIL helps in dealing with the cases of Misinformation and Disinformation
