When IT became the community's saviour

How Microsoft's Project Siksha helped a stranded community struck by the tsunami survive the crisis.

his is the story of how connectivity became a godsend, literally, for a marooned community of islanders when cataclysm visited the Andaman and Nicobar islands last year in the form of the killer tsunami.

Had it not been for Microsoft's Project Siksha that was in operation at the Navodaya Village, 170 km north of Port Blair in the Middle Andaman islands, the small community would have perhaps been completely wiped out.

"Ours was the only school which worked all through the tsunami. When all telephone lines collapsed, relief officials made use of our extensive V-SAT, e-mail and conferencing facilities to communicate with the outside world. Villagers made use of our infrastructure to stay connected," says V. Raghavendra Rao, postgraduate teacher in biology at Navodaya Vidyalaya, who runs Project Siksha. Mr. Rao won this year's Innovative Teacher Leadership Awards given out by Microsoft Corporation India.

Under Project Siksha, Microsoft delivers software solutions, comprehensive training and curriculum leadership to students and teachers. With a US \$20 million investment, Project Siksha aims to reach out to 3.5 million students and 80,000 school teachers across government schools in the country by 2007. Project Siksha was launched by

Microsoft chairman Bill Gates during his India visit in November 2002. At the Navodaya Vidayalaya, Pro-




ready on at schools in Uttaranchal, Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Punjab, Karnataka, West Bengal and Maharashtra.





