ICT Tools Dashboard

This is the control panel where you can adjust settings, add questions, publish the test, and view results.

Tasks

0. **Bookmark this page and write down your password**
It is absolutely critical that you do this! There is no way to recover the URL or password.
1. **Adjust settings**
Change the test name, description and what happens after the test is graded.
2. **Add questions**
It's not much of a test if it doesn't have questions.
3. **Publish & distribute**
Publish your test, distribute it to your students and start collecting results.
4. **View results**
See how well your students did on the test.

Controlling the Access

Who can take your test?

Anyone

Anyone who enters a **passcode** of my choosing

Set the passcode your students will need to enter to start the test

It is case sensitive.

Password

Anyone who enters a **unique identifier** (student ID, employee ID, etc) from a list that I specify

Anyone who enters an **email address** from a list that I specify

What should test takers enter to identify themselves?

This text appears above the field where the test taker enters their identifier. It should tell them *what* to enter.

Examples: "Enter your name", "Enter your student ID", or "Please enter your company email address"

How much time do test takers have to complete the test?

The timer starts the moment they enter the test and continues even if they close out of the test.
