
Why take micro-improvement initiatives?



Vidya Amrit Mahotsav - Phases




How to conduct Vidya Amrit Mahotsav project

- 4. Analyse the **impact** of the action steps


How to submit my Innovative solution on DIKSHA app

What should Vidya Amrit Mahotsav journey video have

- 1. Has a logical flow
- 2. Is free of factual errors
- 3. Is not more than 5 minutes long
- 4. Is not more than 50 MB in size
- 5. Includes evidences in the form of short video clips, photographs in the video
- 6. Does not have any discriminatory content based on age, gender, religion, community, disability etc.
- 7. Does not have copyright and IPR violations
- 8. Does not have any hate speech, defamation or violence
- 9. Has consistent font size, colour, and style for headings / sub-headings / supportive text
- 10. Has clear, modulated and comprehensible audio
