Protect your privacy on YouTube

- Think carefully before you post personal information. This includes things like the town you live in, your workplace or school, and your home address.
- Protect your account data and don't share your password with others. YouTube employees will
 never ask you for your password. Don't be fooled if someone contacts you pretending to be
 from YouTube.
- Get permission first. As a rule of thumb, you should get permission before filming other people or posting their personal information.
- Visit the YouTube **Privacy and Safety Settings** page for a list of tools that you can use to manage your content and experience on the site.
- Always follow best practices for keeping your Google account secure.
- For stronger security, keep your accounts secured through the **2-step verification**.

Using the same password for everything online means that if one password is compromised, you lose everything.




Check that your security details are all up to date at google.com/myaccount

Use 2-Step Verification

- 2-Step Verification is extra-protection for your Google account.

Signing in to your account will work a little differently

- You'll enter your password

 Whenever you sign in to Google, you'll enter your password as usual.
- 2 You'll be asked for something else
 Then, a code will be sent to your phone via text, voice
 call, or our mobile app. Or, if you have a Security Key,
 you can insert it into your computer's USB port.

Video Privacy Settings

PUBLIC VIDEOS can be seen by anyone at YouTube. They can also be shared with anyone using YouTube. They're posted on your channel when you upload them and show up in search results and related video lists.

UNLISTED VIDEOS and playlists can be seen and shared by anyone with the link. They won't appear to others who visit the "Videos" tab of your channel page. They won't show up in YouTube's search results unless someone adds your unlisted video to a public playlist.

You can share an unlisted video's URL with other people. The people you share the video with don't need a Google Account to see the video. Anyone with the link can also re-share it.


PRIVATE VIDEOS and playlists can only be seen by you and the people you choose. Your private videos won't appear to others who visit the "Videos" tab of your channel page. They also won't show up in YouTube's search results.


Note: Comments are not available on private videos. If you want to allow comments on a video that's not publicly available, change the privacy setting to unlisted.





Restricted Mode

- In the dialog box that appears, toggle Restricted Mode to on or off.






