From the Joint Director's Desk

In the new financial year, like previous years, CIET will be taking up the programmes approved by the Institutional Advisory Board (IAB), Programme Advisory Committee of NCERT and Programme Advisory Board of MoE. This year, the institution will be taking up 27 programmes for execution in accordance with the vision of NEP 2020.

A Summer Camp for children (classes VI-X) on Digital Learning and Multimedia was organized from 6-17 June 2022. About 76 participants attended the camp where they were exposed to various activities related to storytelling, coding, animation and ICT tools related to creation of audio and video eContent. The camp had 30 sessions taken by 25 resource persons.

A two-day preparatory orientation programme for functionaries of States/UTs for the launch of 200+ DTH TV channels under PM eVIDYA was organised by CIET-NCERT from 30-31 May 2022 at BISAG-N and GCERT, Gandhinagar, Gujarat in collaboration with BISAG-N, GCERT, Vidya Samiksha Kendra (VSK), Gandhinagar, Gujarat. In all, about 87 participants representing 27 States/UTs including Directors/Joint Directors and other senior officials of SCERTs participated in the meeting. The participants were oriented for aspects related to eContent development, preparation of schedules, management of data and overall running of DTH TV channels.

Training programmes and production of programmes for various subjects and topics related to NCERT's curriculum, Indian Sign Language (ISL), Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) and Learning Outcomes (LO) were also carried out as part of the regular activities. Live sessions on ICT tools, Sahyog and inclusive education were telecast on PMeVIDYA DTH TV Channels.

CIET was conferred with the UNESCO's King Hamad Bin Isa Al-Khalifa Prize for the Use of Information and Communication Technologies in Education for its digital Initiatives for Inclusive and Accessible Education on 24 June 2022, Paris.

We will keep our stakeholder updated on the activities and interventions carried out by the institution on a regular basis.

CIET was conferred with the UNESCO King Hamad Bin Isa Al-Khalifa Prize for the Use of Information and Communication Technologies in Education for its project Initiatives for Inclusive and Accessible Education on 24 June 2022, Paris. Joint Director, CIET received the prize, which constitute a citation, medal and 25,000 USD cost award.

In **an evaluative study of ICT @ School Scheme under Samagra Shiksha**, the expected outcomes of the proposed research are Mobile App for gathering information on KPI's of ICT @ School Scheme, Implementation data of 88,993 schools w.r.t. to ICT @ School Scheme, Capacity building of teachers and other functionaries in aspirational districts for implementation of ICT @ School Scheme. These tentative outcomes may provide insights to the educational planners, administrators, teachers, parents and learners towards harnessing the optimum potential of available ICT infrastructure to ensure access, equity and quality of education. Collection of related literature and research tools related to ICT in School Education is in progress. Parakh app has been explored to study the type and framework of possible questions. During 2017-18 third party evaluation study was conducted by CIET and is being used as a reference tool for adapting and formulating tools for the present study.

Under Effectiveness of ICT based accessible interventions (UDL-based e-Contents) of NCERT on holistic development of students with special needs, in house packaging of UDL based eContents is underway in online as well as offline mode. Data gathering tools development related in-house and drafting of tools (questionnaires) for studying the awareness about the UDL based eContent such as ISL videos and audiobooks developed by CIET, NCERT among the students and teachers are in motion. As a whole, this research is likely to provide insights to the planners, producers, teachers and learners towards designing, producing, transaction and consumption of UDL based content.

The draft of a questionnaire for teachers for the project has been developed in **A study of different modes of online education adopted by Elementary and Secondary school teachers during the pandemic.** Review of the literature of online learning initiatives and review of different sample techniques has been done.

In the first phase of the study, in the **Implementing ICT Interventions at School Stage: A Block Level Research Study**, the first objective was achieved and the data collection was completed in 3 blocks and documented in a report. For the second phase of the study, 14 modules for ICT intervention were finalized. Also, the research tools for assessment of knowledge, attitude and skill on ICT were finalized during an online workshop held from 11-13 May 2022.

For the development of eContent for the students of 3-9 years age-group a workshop was organised from 15-17 June 2022 under the **Development and dissemination of eContent at Foundational Literacy and Numeracy level.**

Under the **Development of Curriculum Based materials of Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) Simulation and 3D videos in science for School Education** following tasks were undertaken: i) ePathshala AR mobile app was updated ii) All assets and apps were transferred to CIET, NCERT server for checking iii) 14 3D rendered AR videos were developed out of which 12 were uploaded on DIKSHA portal and mapped with textbooks

Development and dissemination of educational audio-video programs supports the enhancement of teachinglearning among students, teachers, educators and other stakeholders. In **Development and Dissemination of Educational Media Programmes,** various forms of audio and video programmes were produced. The audio unit of CIET produced 509 programmes and the video unit produced 226 programmes in this quarter of the year.

In April, Cyber Jagrookta Diwas sessions were conducted on the theme 'Mental and Emotional Well-being in the Era of Cyberspace' in which five weekly sessions were conducted. Quiz on 'Mental and Emotional Wellbeing in the Cyberspace' was launched on 22 April 2022. Cyber Jagrookta Diwas sessions were conducted on the theme 'Social Engineering Attacks' in May 2022 in which one panel discussion and three technical sessions were conducted. Quiz on "Social Engineering Attacks" was launched by CIET, NCERT in collaboration with ISEA, C-DAC, Hyderabad on 20 May 2022. In June, Cyber jagrookta Diwas sessions were conducted on the theme 'Financial Frauds by

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misusing Social Media Platforms' in which one panel discussion and three technical sessions were conducted. Quiz on "Digital Financial Safety" was launched by CIET-NCERT in collaboration with ISEA, C-DAC, Hyderabad on 17 June 2022.

Under the **Standardization of Indian Sign Language**, a module writing workshop for ISL course was held on 19-20 May 2022. The first draft of all 6 modules were collected and were under review. Another Workshop on Development of Signs for Academic Terms was conducted from 23-26 May 2022 with the purpose to develop signs for academic terms of the NCERT class VI textbook Mathematics. Workshop on Validation of New Signs for Academic Terms was also held from 31 May-03 June 2022. The words from the NCERT textbook Political Science Class VI and VII Social and Political Life, History of Class VI Our Pasts, Maths Class VI Mathematics were validated during the workshop. A Workshop on Finalization of word lists for collecting the sign variants from states/UTs and developing SoPs for data collection was held on 23-24 June 2022.

A 6-days online training on Specific Learning Disabilities was held from 20-25 June 2022. Total 25,547 registrations were received for the 6-days training programme. All the live sessions under learning disability online training transmitted live on PM eVIDYA DTH Channels for class 1 to 12 and simulcast on NCERT OFFICIAL YouTube Channel at 12:00 noon to 12:30 pm from 20th to 25th June 2022. The webinar sessions were bilingual (Hindi and English) accompanied by Indian Sign Language Interpreter (ISL). The discussion sessions were facilitated by a professional anchor.

In the **Resource cum Activity Center in ET/ICT for school and Teacher Training**, a Field Work for 40 students of Diploma in ISL Interpretation (DISLI) from ISLRTC, New Delhi was organised to observe the textbook ISL recordings from 11-29 April 2022. An orientation programme for Campaign Planning Project of 20 students of Advertising & Public Relations, Indian Institute of Mass Communication, Delhi was organised on 4 April 2022. An internship programme for 02 M.Phil. and Ph.D. students from NIEPA, Delhi was organised from 20 June-31 July 2022. Exposure Visits of 373 B.Ed, B.El.Ed. and Mass Communication students and Faculty members from JIMS, Greater Noida; IIMC, Delhi; FIMT, Delhi; St. Lawrence College, Delhi and K.R Mangalam University, Gurugram, Haryana were organised in this quarter.

A 2-weeks Summer Camp for Children in Digital Learning and Multimedia was organised from 6-17 June, 2022 at CIET, NCERT, New Delhi. A total of 676 registrations were received, out of which 100 were invited and 76 participants attended the camp. The camp was spread over 30 sessions on different themes like coding, cartoon making & animation, puppetry, learning different subjects in fun ways, hands on experiment, 360 degree photography, learnings through lens, augmented reality and virtual reality, sessions on inclusion, cyber safety and security, world of books, script writing & story boarding, audio and video media production, dance forms, yoga, toy making and session on Digital Initiatives. For this, more than 25 resource persons were invited. The valedictory session was held in the presence of Prof. Amerender P. Behera, Joint Director, CIET, NCERT; faculty members of CIET, NCERT, parents and 76 children. It was accompanied with performances on Ganpati vandana, nukkad natak, poem recitation, dance and presentation by the children. The session was concluded with the vote of thanks and awarding certificates and bags to all the participants.

A total of 12 books were purchased for CIET Library in this quarter.

In **Online Publication of Indian Journal of Educational Technology and Quarterly Newsletter of CIET**, the July 2022 issue of CIET's journal, Indian Journal of Educational Technology was compiled and finalised. The January-March 2022 issue of CIET's Newsletter was also published on CIET's website.

Under **Development and Maintenance of Websites**, **Mobile Apps and Other Digital Activities** the following tasks were carried out:

- i. NCERT's latest textbooks were updated on the website.
- ii. Security Audit of 7 applications was done.
- iii. SRS and prototype of CIET's new website were completed and peer-reviewed and the process of content migration was initiated.
- iv. Testing of ICT awards portal was done.
- v. QR Code testing of all textbooks was done.

- vi. ePathshala Mobile App upgradation was initiated for NVDA and the website was modified and updated with textbooks in flipbook format (SQL, TTS, etc).
- vii. TSAR Code road map was started
- viii. Regular uploading of documents, vacancy notifications, tenders, audio programmes etc. were done
- ix. Creation of flipbooks and ePUB for textbooks of 2022-23 was carried out
- x. Vulnerability reports received by NIC were solved
- xi. ICT awards portal was made live for entries from all over India.
- xii. Public Grievances portal has been created under NCERT's website and monitoring is being carried out on a weekly basis.
- xiii. CIET legacy web site content documentation was made ready for merging with migration and security certificates.
- xiv. Kala Utsav application portal was under development.
- xv. Security Certificate of 7 Apps completed and ready in staging.

Figure-1: Analytics of ePathshala till June 2022





Figure-2: Mobile apps of NCERT with app downloads till June 2022

The two-day preparatory orientation programme for functionaries of States/UTs for the launch of 200+ DTH TV channels under PM eVIDYA was organised by CIET-NCERT from 30-31 May 2022 at BISAG-N and GCERT, Gandhinagar, Gujarat in collaboration with BISAG-N, GCERT, Vidya Samiksha Kendra (VSK), Gandhinagar, Gujarat. Prof. Dinesh Prasad Saklani, Director, NCERT, New Delhi; Prof. Amarendra P. Behera, Joint Director, CIET-NCERT, New Delhi; Dr. T.P. Singh, Director General, BISAG-N, Gandhinagar, Gujarat; Dr. P. A. Jalu, Director, GCERT and Dr. T.S. Joshi, Former Director, GCERT graced the occasion. The 12 eVIDYA DTH TV channels are run in 24x7 mode. Currently, the total duration of the fresh programmes daily on the telecast is 2.5 to 3 hours (2.5 hours for classes 1-9 and 3 hours for classes 10-12) in both Hindi and English mediums. A half an hour extra slot for ISL has been created for classes 1-5 in the existing two hours duration and for vocational education from classes 6-9. The Class-wise and subject-wise details of the videos are given in table-7.




Figure-3: Class-wise details of the ISL videos (Tt=733)




Figure-4: Class-wise details of Vocational videos produced till June 2022

Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA venture also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (15 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 Community Radio Stations), 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps. Till June 2022, 3,507 pieces of curriculum-based radio programmes (Classes 1-12) have been disseminated for broadcast. And till now 1341 Live Programs have been broadcast through iRadio and JioSaavn apps.







Fig-5: Details of Calls Received on IVRS during April-June 2022


