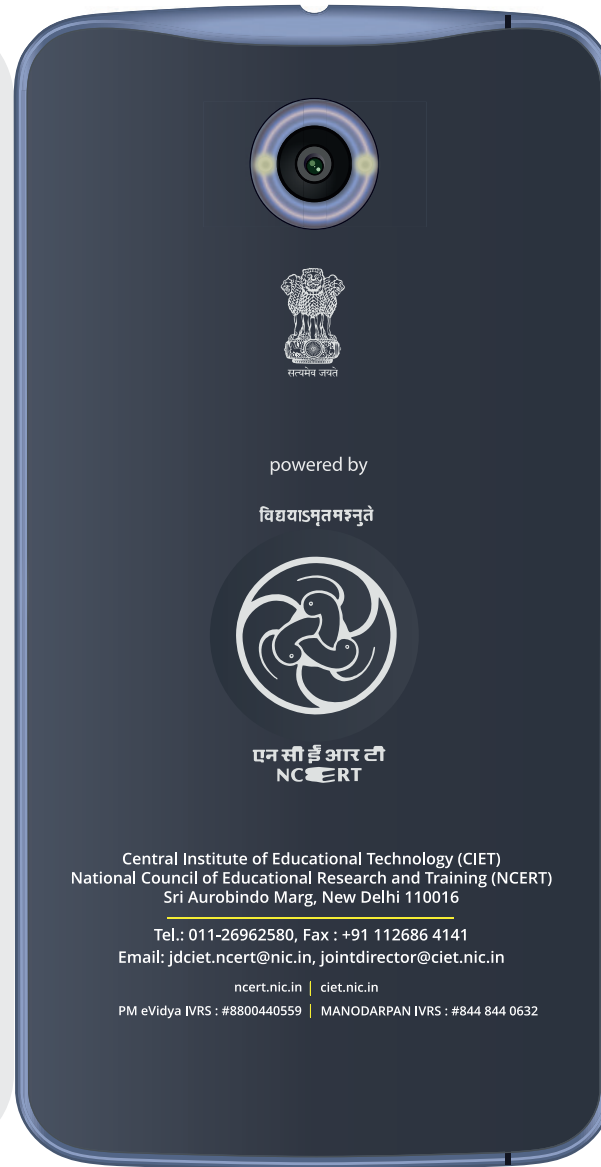

## The eBooks

Students, teachers, educators and parents can access ebooks through multiple technology platforms, i.e., mobile phones and tablets (as ePub) and from the web through laptops and desktops (as Flipbooks). ePathshala also allows users to download and carry as many books as their devices supports. Features of these books allow users to read offline, select, zoom, bookmark, highlight, navigate, search, read in day/ night mode and make notes digitally.
