Education for All - To impart foundational literacy and numeracy, critical life skills for Citizens.



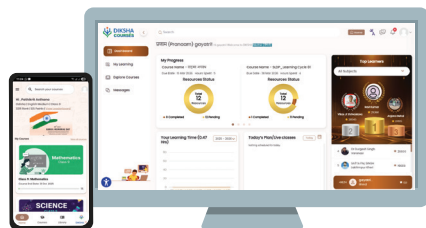
Virtual Labs - Access for students to enhance actual laboratory experiences.

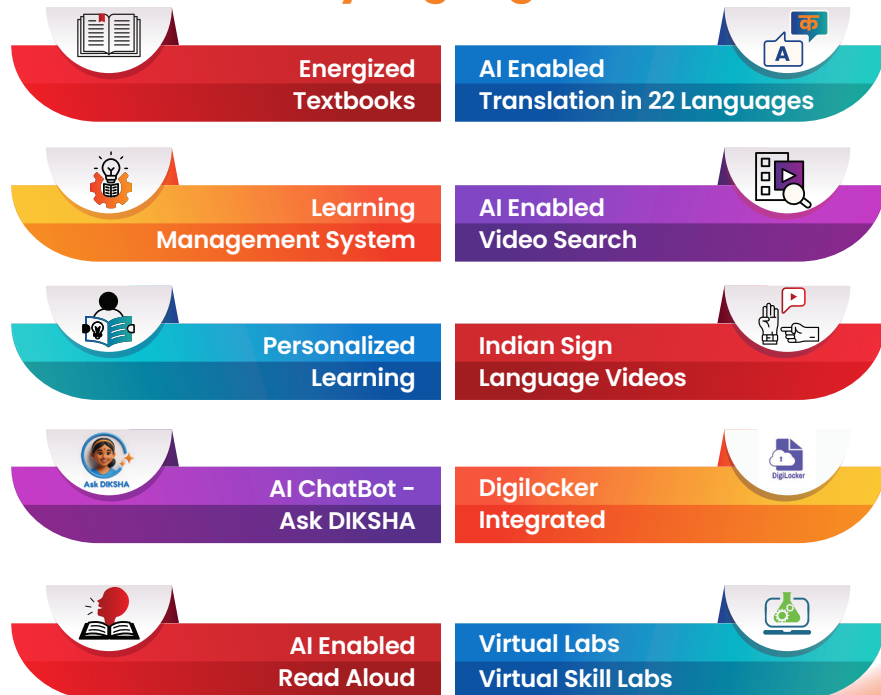
About DIKSHA

Under the initiative of "One Nation, One Digital Platform," DIKSHA serves as a unified digital infrastructure to support teaching and learning nationwide.

The platform empowers students, teachers, and education stakeholders by providing free access to multilingual, high-quality, curriculum-linked digital learning resources, including textbooks, videos, practice questions, and courses.

An initiative of the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) under the aegis of the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, DIKSHA was launched in 2017 by the then Honourable Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu. Since its launch, the platform has been adopted by all States and Union Territories, along with central autonomous bodies and boards including CBSE, making it one of the largest digital education initiatives in India.

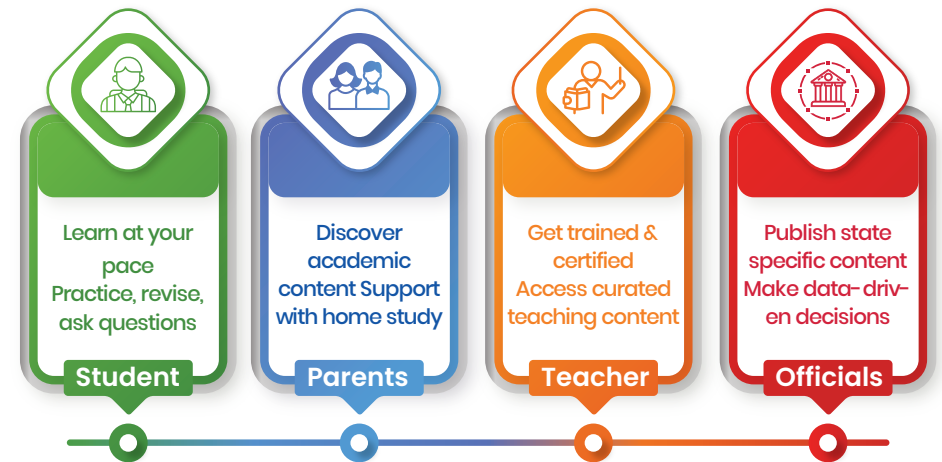
