- Schools will have to signup using their UDISE+ code on web portal <https://shvr.education.gov.in>
- Swachh Vidyalaya Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating 2025-26 or on mobile app, "Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating 2025-26"
- Fill the required information (Self-assessment form)
- The performance of the schools against different categories will be scored and the schools would be given a star rating
- Concerned department will appoint a Nodal Officer, at the District/State level to overview & coordinate the implementation of the SHVR activities in the district.

Who Can Participate



All government, government aided and private schools in both urban and rural areas can register using their UDISE+ code.

Journey of SHVR



About SHVR

- **Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya Rating (SHVR)** provides a ready opportunity to inculcate relevant fundamental duties: citizenship skills and values among the students with linkage to environmental awareness including water, sanitation and hygiene, resource conservation as visualized under the National Education Policy 2020.
- **SHVR** packages – Toilets, Handwashing with Soap, Water, Operation and Maintenance, Behavior Change and Capacity building, Mission LiFE activities.
- Functionals – Effective functioning using ICT tools, behavior change communication, new financing options and forging partnerships.
- **SHVR** based situation analysis is instrumental to identify infrastructure and service level gaps linked to development of school level **Swachhata Action Plan (SAP)**, as envisaged under **Samagra Shiksha**.
- Key stakeholders (Rural/Urban Local Body, Government Agencies such as Districts and State/UTs, Civil Society Organizations)
- In the **Swachh Vidyalaya Puraskar (SVP) 2021-22**, a significant approx. 8.23 lakh schools participated from all States and Union Territories (UTs). Now **SVP** is upgraded to **Swachh Evam Harit Vidyalaya (SHVR) 2025**.
- **SHVR** is applicable to Government Schools, Government Aided Schools and Private Schools from both Rural and Urban areas.

Objectives

1. Promoting Cleanliness

Ensure clean and well-maintained school premises through sanitation, regular cleaning, and effective waste disposal systems.

2. Hygiene Education

Educate students on personal hygiene and public health practices like handwashing, dental care, and cleanliness.

3. Environmental Sustainability

Promote environmental sustainability with green practices such as rainwater harvesting, recycling, renewable energy, and developing green spaces.

4. Involvement of Community

Engage students, teachers, parents, and the local community in cleanliness drives and awareness initiatives for lasting impact.

5. Monitoring and Rewards

Periodically monitor schools for cleanliness and green practices, with recognition and rewards for outstanding efforts.



Key Categories Of SHVR

SHVR empowers schools to assess themselves under six key categories — Water, Toilets, Handwashing, Operation & Maintenance, Eco Friendly Green School & Mission LiFE, Behavior Change & Capacity Building and be recognized at district, state, and national levels.
