From the **Joint Director's Desk**



Like in previous quarters, CIET continued with its activities in the quarter from October-December 2023. Interventions in educational technology were made under various projects for school education.

We organized a six phase capacity building programme between October to December for e-content developers from states/union territories/autonomous bodies for development of quality content under PM eVidya 200 DTH TV channels.

The monthly DIKSHA coordination meetings were held with coordinators from states/union territories in order to track the progress made under DIKSHA.

Many online trainings were organized in this quarter to make learners adept at cyber safety and security.

CIET also invited entries for All India Children's Educational eContent Competition - 2023-24, the last date for which was extended till 10th January 2024.

In order to develop cyber safety and security intervention package, a workshop for "Development of the Cyber Safety and Security Intervention Package" was organised at CIET. CIET celebrated the Cyber Awareness month in October 2023 during which various panel discussions, workshops and even a nukkad natak was staged in order to raise awareness about cyber safety and security in today's age.

Online trainings were also organized in December 2023 to understand the pedagogical perspectives of virtual labs.

Live interactive sessions were regularly held every Friday under the Manodarpan initiative to ensure the mental well-being of students. Besides, CIET also celebrated the Constitution day on 26th November and the International Day of Persons with Disabilities on 3rd December 2023 in order to promote awareness and inclusivity.

We will continue to keep our stakeholders updated about the diverse activities for educational technology that are being undertaken by our organization.

Under the **study of Feedback towards PM e-Vidya Program of Teachers and Students across the country**, data collection was carried out in different districts-to ascertain feedback on education through TV- after having meetings with all regional institutes of education (RIEs).

In the project on **Effectiveness of Techno-Pedagogy Content Integration (TPCI) package on development of Digital Competencies of Inservice teachers at secondary level**, the ICT- Basic tool was under review process and the ICT-Basic training Package was also organized.

Under the Study of the Awareness on Cyber safety and Security Among Secondary Students (Class IX to XII), a workshop was organized at CIET in November for review of research tool items with help from faculties from esteemed universities in development of these research items. Besides, another two days workshop was held at CIET which saw experts from various organizations like I4C, CBSE, KVS, CPF involved in the development of the Cyber Safety and Security intervention package. Another one day workshop was held at CIET for review and development of the Cyber Safety and Security Awareness Scale.

Under the **study of quality of eContent on DIKSHA and usage patterns and user behaviours**, a thorough review of literature was completed after which drafts of survey questionnaires for phase 1 of survey were developed.

Under **Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts for classes 1 & 2**, two workshops were held in October, one on Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts for classes 1 & 2 for Hindi Language during which 16 Scripts were developed and another on Development of Programme Scripts for classes 1 & 2 for Urdu Language during which 20 Scripts were developed. Similarly, a workshop was held in November for development of scripts for English in which 16 scripts were developed. Besides, 2 audio programmes were also produced.

Under **Development and Implementation of Curricula for ICT in Education for School systems based on NEP 2020**, 13 webinars for developing capacity on ET & ICT were organized. More details of activities undertaken in it are presented in Table 1.

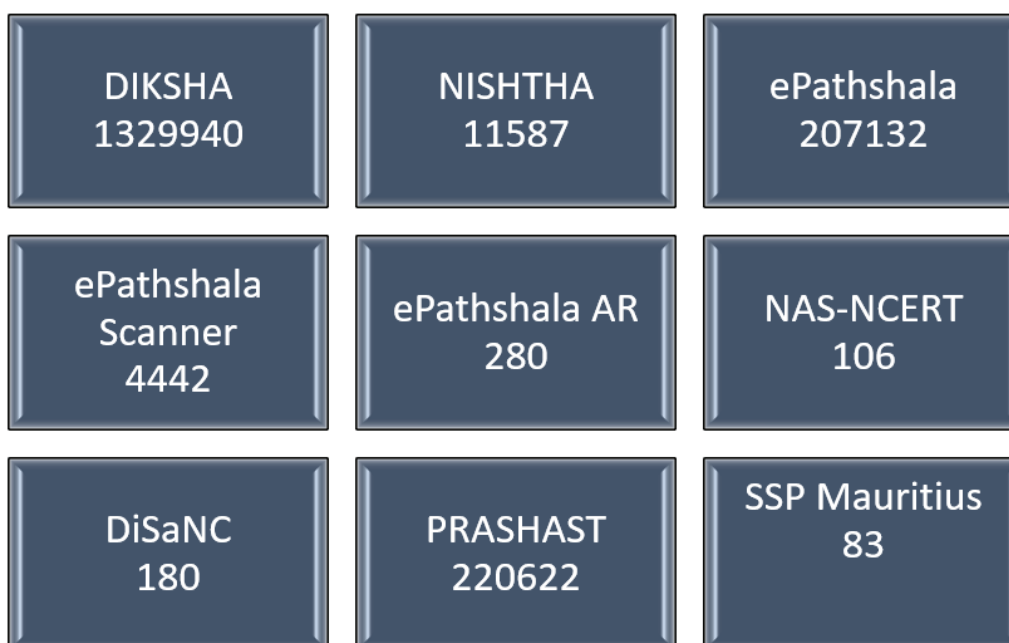
Work was carried out under **Development and Maintenance of Websites, Mobile Apps and Other Digital Activities as well**. The following tasks were completed under this:-

- Flipbook Creation and Integration: All 20 Chandrayaan modules for both Hindi and English languages have been converted to Flipbook format and uploaded to the server.
- Developed Bhartiya Bhasha Utsav Portal to submit weekly activity reports and its dashboard are currently in the developmental phase and also developed Chandrayaan portal's user interface.
- NCERT BHARATIYA BHASHA UTSAV webpages in multiple languages eg. Hindi, English, Bengali, Odia, Urdu, Kannada, Sanskrit, Telugu , Malyalam, Tamil, Maithili, Dogri, Gujarati, Kashmiri, Marathi , Punjabi , Nepali, Bodo, Manipuri, Konkani, Assamese, Santhali were created.

Figure-2: Mobile apps with installed audience between October and December

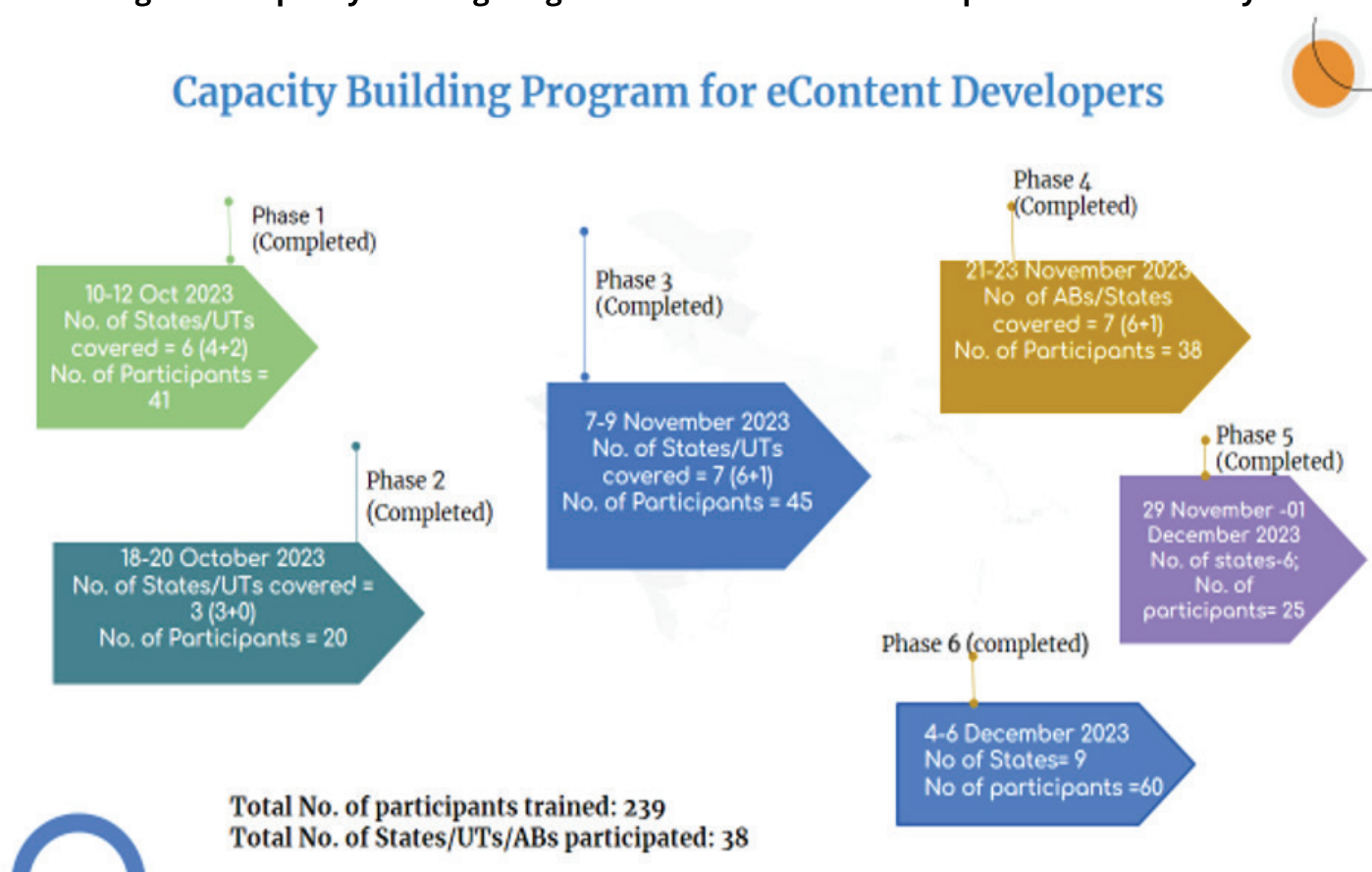


Under **PM eVidya Management of 200 DTH TV channels and Radio Broadcasts and Podcast**, the following progress was made

- Test run of all 200 PM eVidya DTH TV channels having begun w.e.f. 29th July, 2023, continued with regular scheduling of the telecast of programs by States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies.

- Signing MoUs with remaining States and UTs on board was under progress.
- Six phases of the Capacity Building Programs for eContent Developers of PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels were held from October 2023 to December 2023 with 239 participants from 38 States/UTs and autonomous bodies. Each phase was of three days' duration wherein both lectures from experts and hands-on training of production and post-production processes was provided to participants. Figure 3 gives details about the programme.
- An online meeting with PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels' nodal officers from States/UTs for coordination of tasks related to the operation the 200 PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels was also conducted wherein various issues were raised and resolved.
- National Instructional Media Institute (NIMI), Chennai on the behalf of MoSDE coordinated with CIET, NCERT for undertaking the operation of 6 PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels allotted to MoSDE. A copy of MoU was shared along with the letter inviting to sign the MoU with NCERT for running the channels.

PMeVidya DTH-TV Live telecast (as on 31st December 2023) Cumulative records:

1. Class 1 to 10 Live programmes: 2,555 Live interactive sessions of 30 minutes each have been telecast on class based channels (1 to 10). It covered about 1,277.5 hours of telecast.
2. Class 11 & 12 Live programmes: 254 live interactive sessions of 60 minutes each have been telecast based on class based channels (11 & 12). It covered about 254 hours of telecast.
3. SAHYOG: guidance and counselling for mental health and wellbeing of children: 761 live sessions of counselling 'SAHYOG: guidance for mental wellbeing of children' have been transmitted live covering about 380.5 hours.
4. Webinar on ICT tools: 787 webinars on ICT tools each for one hours have been telecast for teachers, teacher educators and stakeholders. It covered about 787 hours of telecast.
5. Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms : 497 live sessions of 'Teaching Learning Inter-

ventions for Inclusive Classrooms' have been transmitted live covering about 248.5 hours

6. Manodarpan Live interactive sessions : 98 webinar sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #6 to #12 covering 147 hours.
7. Live interactive sessions on National Student Outreach Program, Listening to Learn (Science & Technology) : 51 Live interactive sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #10 to 12 covering 51 hours.
8. Live interactive sessions on School Leadership in collaboration with NCSL, NIEPA : 79 Live interactive sessions have been transmitted on PMeVidya channels 06, 09 & 12 covering 39.5 hours
8. A live yoga series in collaboration with Ministry of Ayush and Morarji Desai National Institute of Yoga: 334 Live interactive sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #06 to #12 covering 250.5 hours (45 minutes each)

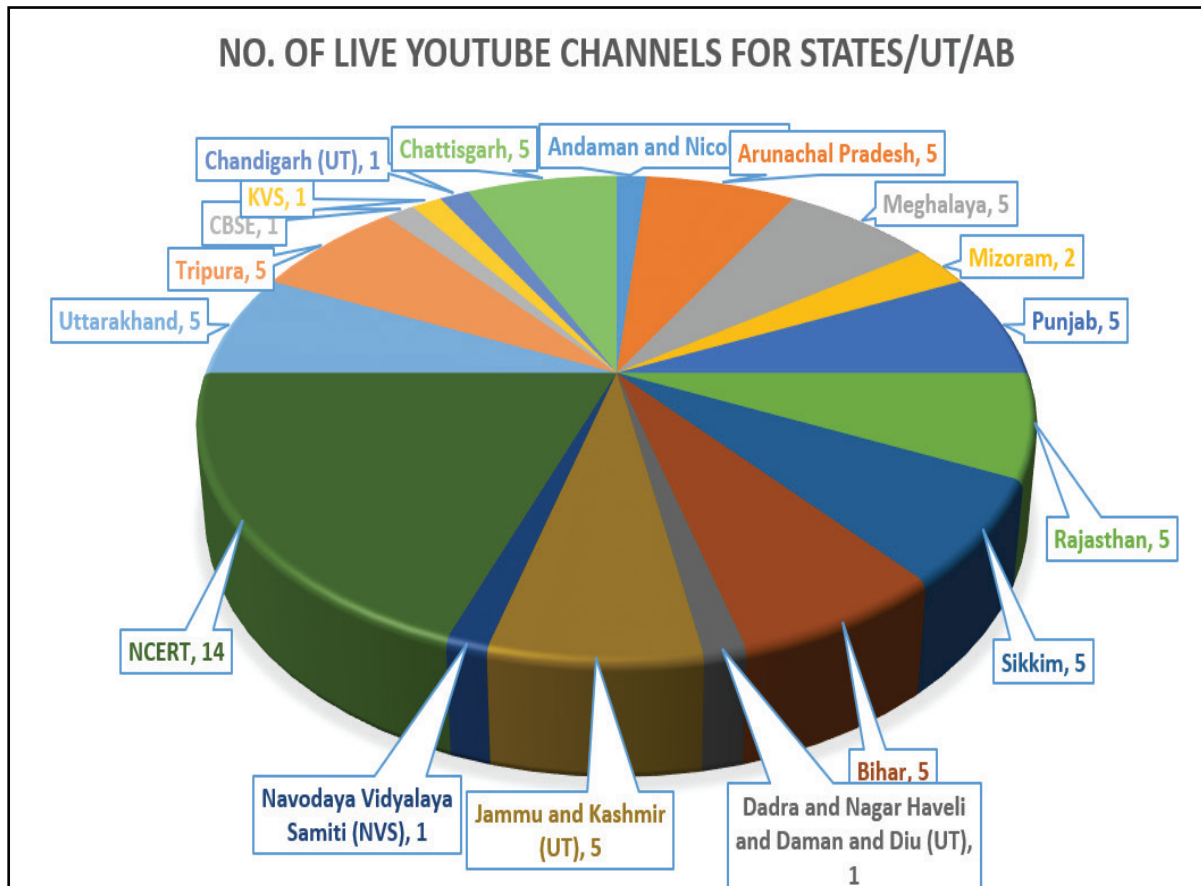

Figure 5: IVRS Calls from October to December 2023

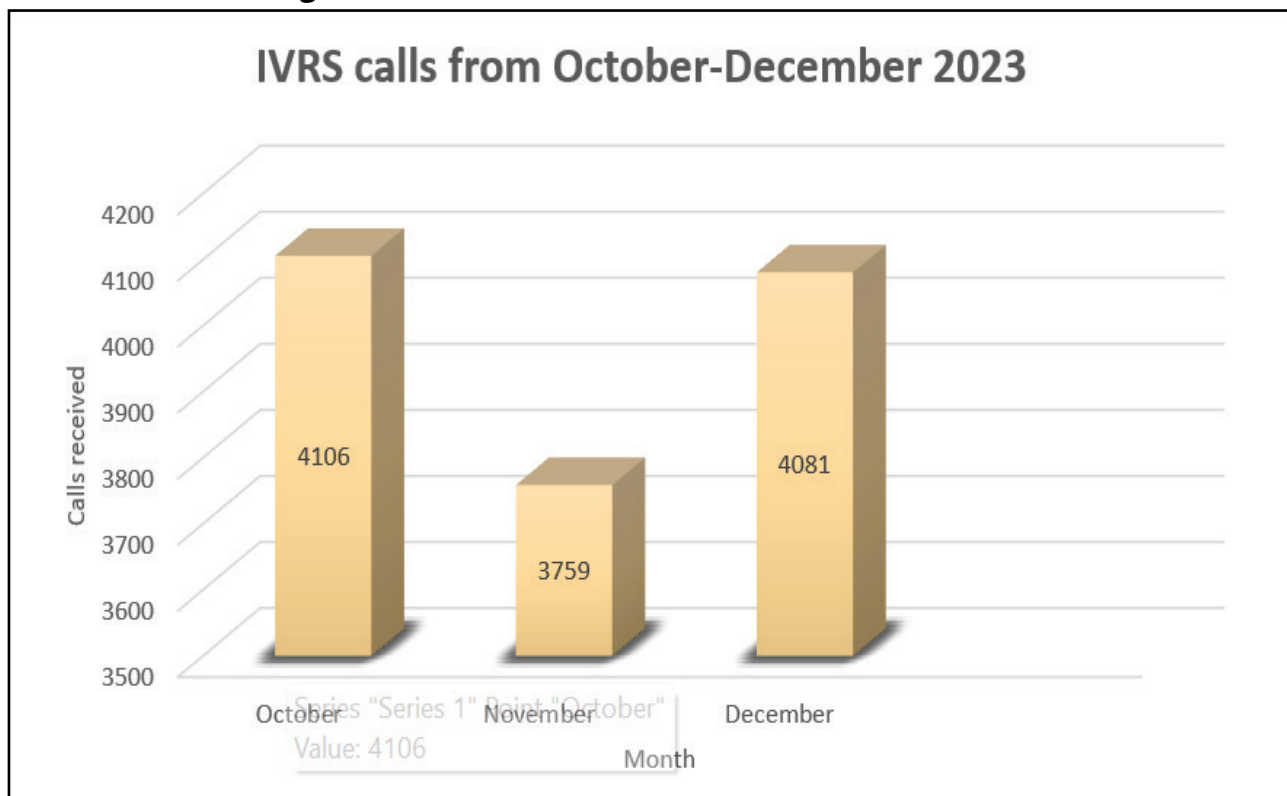


Figure 6: Class-wise email queries received till December 2023

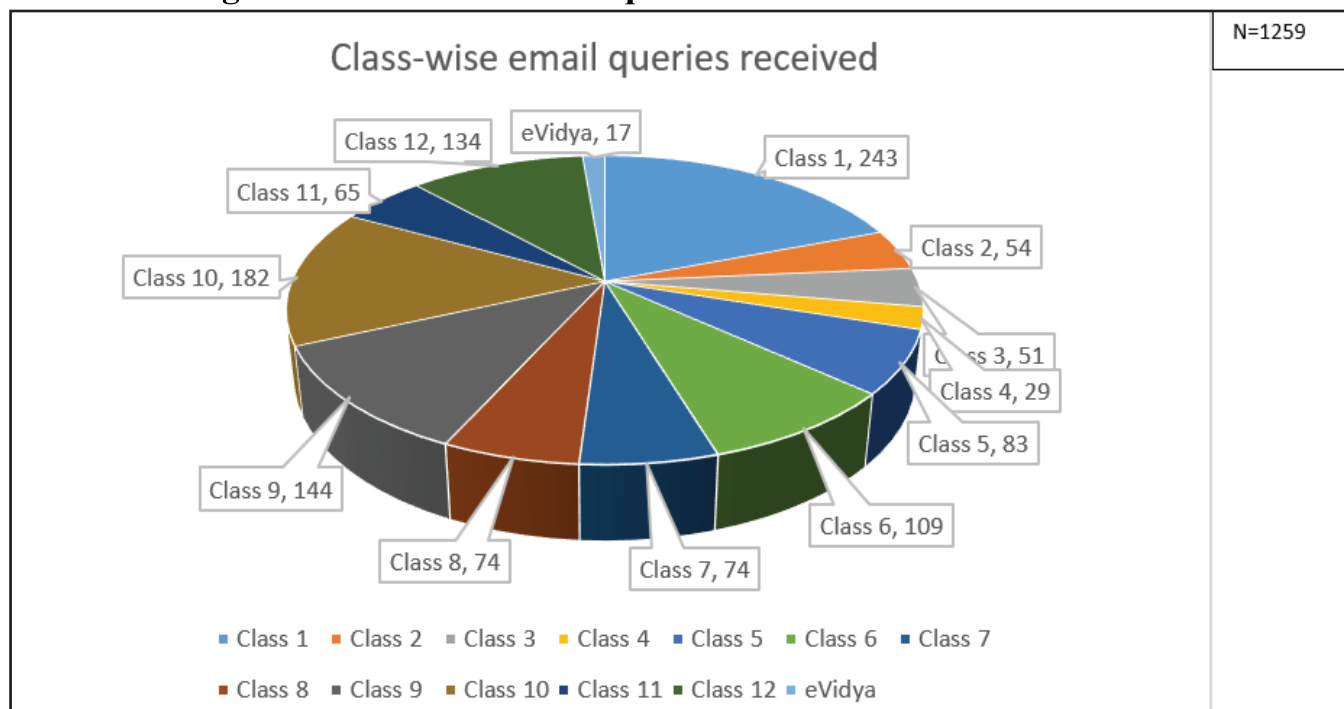
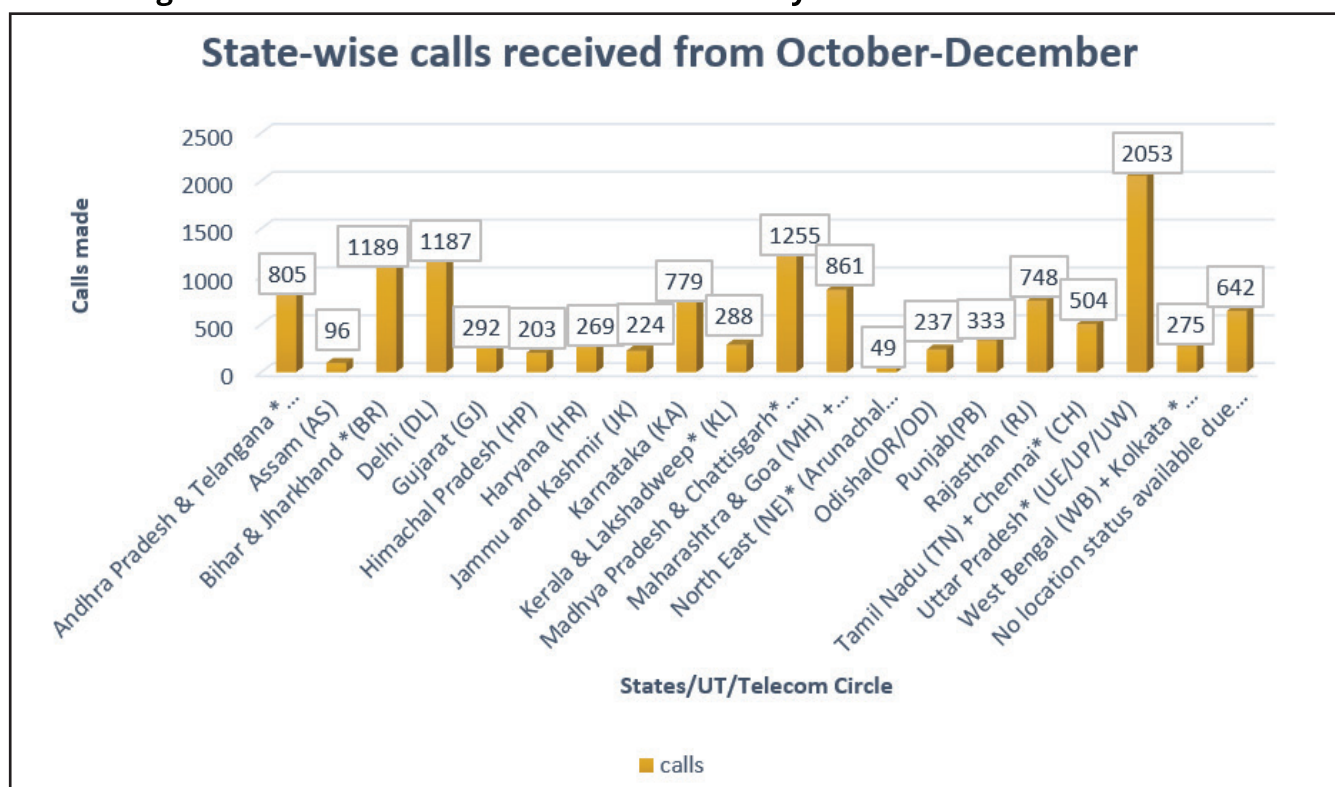


Figure 7: State-wise calls received on PM eVidya from October to December



Under the flagship initiative **DIKSHA - One Nation One Digital Platform**, the following progress was made:

- Online Training on Development of Online Course for State Resource Group(SRG)/ Master Trainers of States, UTs and Autonomous Organisations was held from 4-8 December, 2023.
- Workshop to review the final assessment to map the learning sought by the participants through the training of the online training on Development of Online Course for State Resource Group(SRG)/ Master Trainers of States, UTs and Autonomous Organisations. The experts reviewed and finalised the final assessment among the 80 questions was developed in-house for assessment.

- Review workshop to shortlist course proposals as submitted by State Resource Groups/ Master Trainers of State/UT and Autonomous Organizations for Development of Online Course was held on 21-22 Dec 2023 in online mode.

Under **Organization of Festival, ICT Mela, contests of digital contents and coordination with States/ UTs**, the All India Children's Educational eContent Competition (AICEeCC) 2023-24 was announced, the brochure for which was finalized in Hindi and English. On account of the overwhelming response, the last date was extended to 10th January 2024.

Under the **Development of National Curriculum Frameworks – Tech Platform**, 12,76,922 responses were received under DiSaNC.

Under **Development of Digital textbooks based on Universal Design of Learning (UDL) Kitaab ek, Padhe Anek**, Touch books for class 1 named Mridang and Sarangi have been developed for testing phase with chapter 1 of each book being developed.

Under **Continuous Professional Development (CPD) through NISHTHA- Educational Technology**, the following progress was achieved:

- NISTHA Elementary- Courses were implemented by Karnataka
- NISHTHA Secondary- Courses were implemented by Karnataka
- NISHTHA FLN -Rerun of 12 courses of NISHTHA FLN (Batch 3) in Hindi, English and Urdu was initiated
- NISHTHA ECCE- Rerun of 06 courses of NISHTHA ECCE (Batch 3) in Hindi and English was initiated.
- NISHTHA Educational Administrators- materials and guidelines for advocacy were being developed.
- Research - Translation of tools developed in the previous workshop on 'Development of Research Tools for studying the effectiveness of NISHTHA Online Programmes' was in progress.

Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (15

GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 Community Radio Stations, 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps.
