From the **Joint Director's Desk**



In the new financial year, like previous years, CIET will be taking up programmes approved by the Institutional Advisory Board, Programme Advisory Committee of NCERT and Programme Advisory Board of MoE. CIET organized a variety of programmes for students and teachers in this quarter. 6th and 7th Phases of PM eVIDYA Training Program for Subject Matter Experts and Channel Coordinators of PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels for different states and autonomous bodies was completed between 17 th to 27 th April 2023. 19 webinar sessions were conducted on diverse themes such as Digital Initiatives in Education, Journey of National ICT Awardee Teacher , Educational technology and Information and Communication technology Tools. Webinars on use and integration of technology in school systems was also held. These were in addition to the Online Trainings conducted on the 'Emerging Trends in Educational Technology' and development of eContent: Audio Resources. Script Committees were held to finalise the programme scripts for development of audio-visual educational content for classes 1 and 2. We also conducted a special session on Cyber Jagrookta Diwas. An Eraksha competition on cyber safety and security was organized. Besides, an online training on safety and security in digital space was conducted from 5-9 June. Thousands registered and participated in this initiative by CIET. CIET also saw visits by delegates from Liberia's Ministry of Education in April 2023. A summer camp for children on Digital Learning and Multimedia was also organized in May 2023 that saw students across various schools of NCR in participation. We hosted students and teachers from across Indian states for training sessions on usage of various ICT Tools in the teaching learning process. They were also provided exposure to Audio/ Video studios, Vidya Samiksha Kendre, Experiential Learning Centre/ Virtual Lab at CIET. Students from NIEPA, IIMC, Delhi, SCERT Delhi, Manipal University and University College of London were some of the many who visited CIET during the month of June. CIET continued with seeking feedback from its stakeholders through IVRS and emails in order to improve its services to the students and teachers. We will keep our stakeholder updated on the activities and interventions carried out by the institution on a regular basis.

Activities Undertaken by CIET

In A study of Feedback towards PM e-Vidya Program of Teachers and Students across the country, items for tools are being developed whilst a survey of related literature is in progress.

Review of the literature on “ICT Training for Teachers” is in progress under **Effectiveness of Techno-Pedagogy Content Integration (TPCI) package on development of Digital Competencies of Inservice teachers at secondary level**. Review of the Online Course named “ICT Basics” by experts is in process. Article on “ICT Competency: Empowering Teachers for 21st century Learning” is underway.

For review of literature of the study, 80 researches have been reviewed and compiled under **A Study of the Awareness on Cyber safety and Security Among Secondary Students (Class IX to XII)**. The development of the Pre-Test in the process.

Script Committee Meeting was held on 7 June 2023 in **Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts for classes 1 & 2**, in which scripts were presented and five scripts were finalised and sent for production.

Under **Development and Implementation of Curricula for ICT in Education for School Systems based on NEP -2020**, two Online Training Programme conducted on 12-16 June 2023 & 26-30 June 2023 on the theme “Emerging Trends in Educational Technology” & “Development of eContent: Audio Resources” respectively. Review of literature on ‘Game-Based Learning’ and ‘OERs’ in progress. Article on ‘Transforming Educators: The journey from Teachers to Digital Teachers’ is underway.

6. QR codes for various textbooks and vacancies are generated from time to time and uploaded on the website.
7. Banners titled "Mann Ki Baat" and "Quad Cyber Campaign from 10-14 April 2024" were created and uploaded on the same for websites and social media platforms.
8. Web page for Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms updated on weekly basis.
9. Web page Capacity building through online training and virtual workshops is updated from time to time.

10. Creation of flipbook for rationalised textbooks of 2023-24 under process.
11. PRASHAST android app modification (updated the version 12 on the google play store).
12. PRASHAST live sessions and Orientation program with technical query interactions is going on weekly basis for continuous improvement of the app for the users.
13. Created flipbook for 12 DTH Educational TV channel transmission schedules and uploaded on the CIET website.

Figure-1 : Analytics of ePathshala from April to June 2023

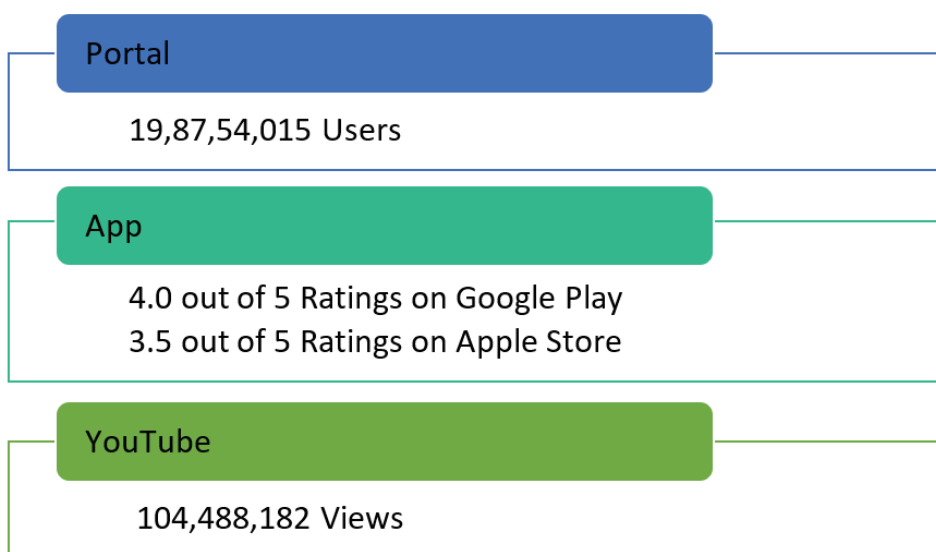
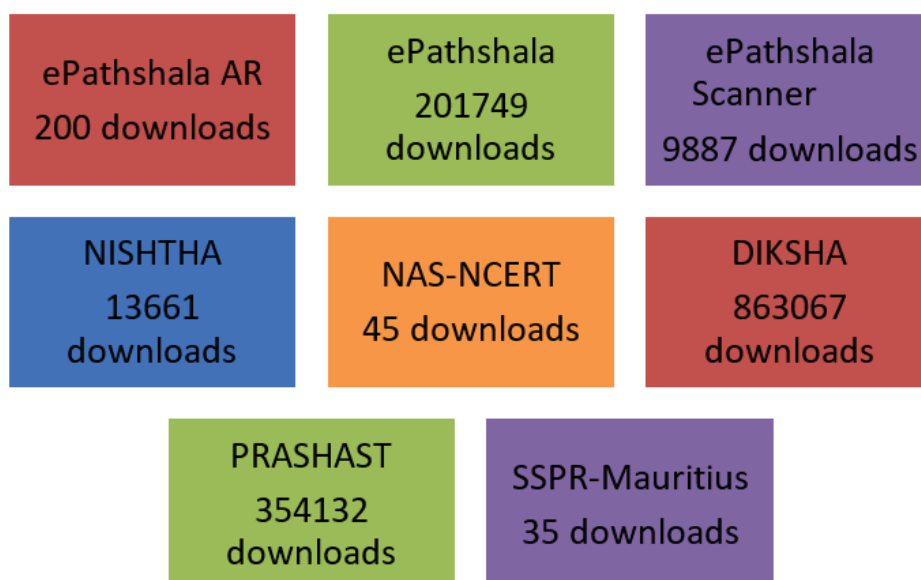


Figure-2 : Mobile apps of NCERT with app downloads between April and June 2023

Under Management of PM e-VIDYA (One Class, One Channel, Radio, Broadcast, Podcasts) the regular works like, dissemination of audio-video eContent was carried out through various radio channels and the 12 DTH TV channels. Dissemination of audio & video programmes for classes 1-12 was done through DTH TV Channels, podcast and radio. Monthly transmission schedules of all the 12 PM eVidya DTH TV channels for the quarter was shared with BISAG as a regular activity.

In second quarter, Training programme for Channel Coordinators and Subject Matter Experts of States/UTs for PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels conducted its sixth and seventh phase training programme in which 90 people participated from CBSE, KVS, NVS, NIOS and CBSE, Puducherry & Tripura respectively.

These 12 eVidya TV channels are run in 24x7 mode. Currently, the total duration of the fresh programmes daily on the telecast is 2 to 3 hours (2 hours for classes 1-9 and 3 hours for classes 10-12). The programmes were produced in both Hindi and English mediums. A half an hour extra slot for ISL has been created for classes 1-5 in the existing two hours duration. The Classwise and subject wise details of the videos are given in Table-8.

Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA venture also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (17 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 CommunityRadio Stations), 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on

iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps. Till end of this quarter, 4,028 pieces of curriculum-based radio programmes (Classes 1-12) were disseminated for broadcast and 2,757 Live Programs were broadcast through iRadio and JioSaavn apps.

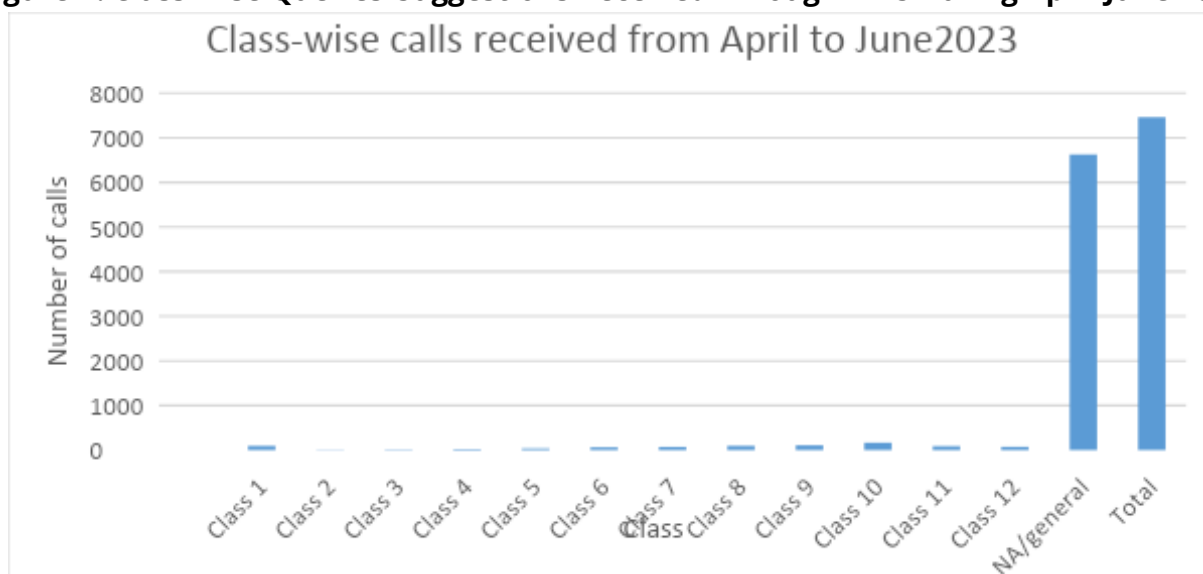

Figure-5 : Development and Implementation of Curricula for ICT in Education for School Systems based on NEP-2020

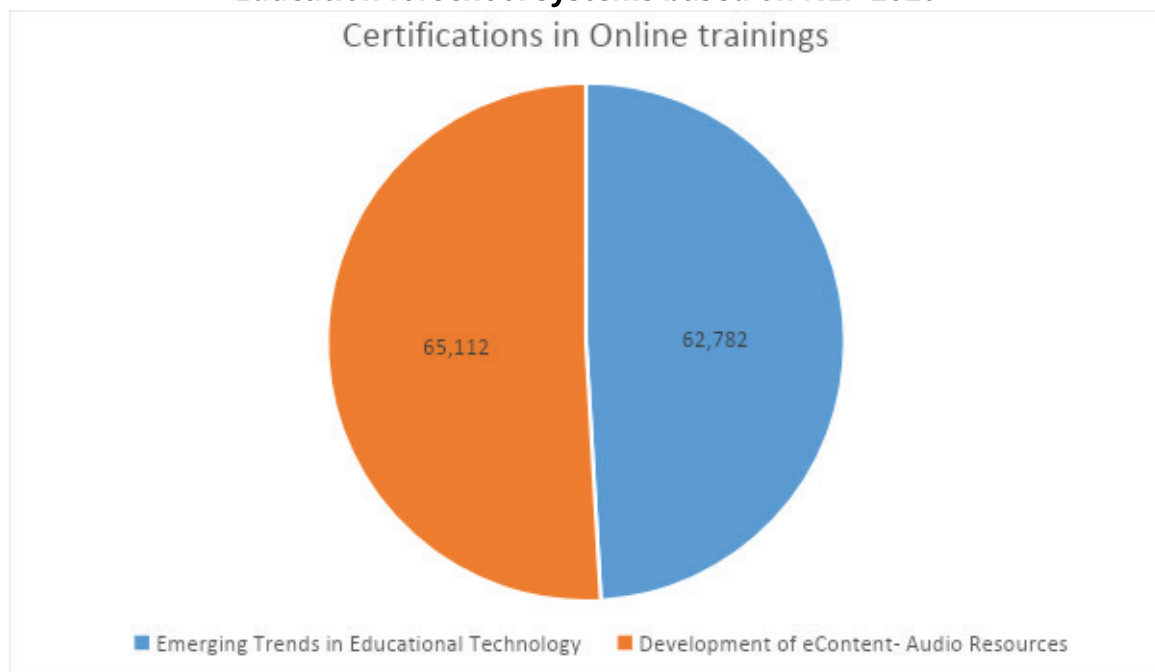
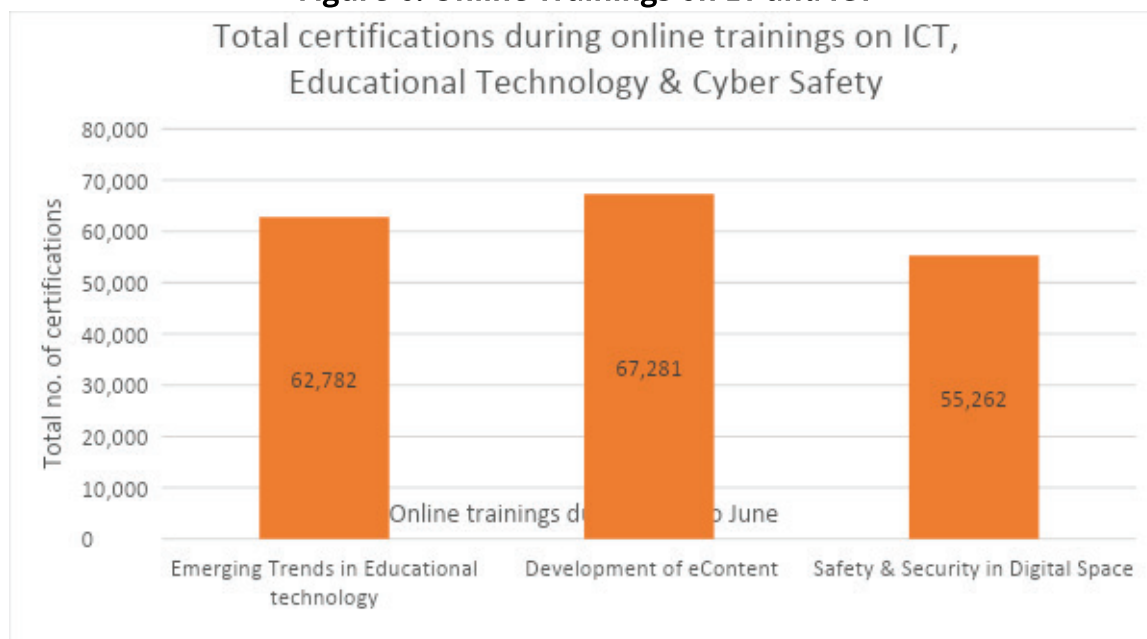


Figure-6: Online Trainings on ET and ICT
