From the

Joint Director's Desk

I am happy to share the details of various programs organized by CIET during the quarter from July to September.

Pursuant to the announcement of 200 DTH TV channels under PM eVidya, we signed formal agreements with most states/union territories/autonomous bodies for its implementation. We began the test run of PM eVidya 200 DTH TV channels allocated to various states/union territories, autonomous bodies in July. In order to ensure multi-modal dissemination of e-content, we also created a separate YouTube channel for each of the 200 DTH TV channel for simulcast of educational content over YouTube.

We organized many live interactive sessions under National Student Outreach Program, Listening to Learn (Science & Technology) to address queries of students across the country. Besides, live sessions for mental wellbeing of students were also conducted under Sahyog in this quarter. Live interactive sessions under PM eVidya were also held for classes 1-12 on diverse range of topics.

The DIKSHA portal was regularly updated with e-content in this quarter. Many energized textbooks of Classes 1 and Class 2 based on NEP-2020 and NCF-FS- 2022 were uploaded on DIKSHA. Besides, energized textbooks developed by states and union territories were also published on DIKSHA. We also organized an online training programme on

"Developing eContent for Teaching and Learning of Mathematics" from 21-25 August 2023. 11 students from colleges across the country completed their internship under the aegis of Planning and Research Division of CIET.

Regular meetings of the Academic Advisory Committee were held in this quarter in order to procure quality educational content. CIET also moderated visits by professionals and students from other organisations in its virtual labs and Experiential Learning Centre.

NCERT also celebrated its 63rd Foundation day on 1st September 2023 wherein it was announced to acquire the status of a Deemed University.

We will continue to keep our stakeholders updated about the diverse activities for educational technology that are being undertaken by our organization.

Under A study of Feedback towards PM e-Vidya Program of Teachers and Students across the country, a detailed review of literature was done comprising research articles and concept papers. It was followed by a four days' tool finalization workshop for various tools i.e., Questionnaire, Checklist, Reaction Scales. These tools are now in the process of being translated into different languages such as Kashmiri, Kannada, Hindi and Odia.

Under the Effectiveness of Techno-Pedagogy Content Integration (TPCI) package on development of Digital Competencies of Inservice teachers at secondary level, development of research tools is under progress and a technical review of the online course 'ICT Basics' by internal team was completed . The outline of 'ICT Pedagogy Integration' course was finalized. Besides, a face-to-face workshop was conducted to review the manuscript of the online Course 'ICT Basics' and development of scripts for Videos. A manuscript was also finalized for 'ICT – Basics' online course. Scripts for the videos of 'ICT – Basics' online course were developed. The introductory video was also recorded for the 'ICT-Basic' course.

Under A Study of the Awareness on Cyber safety and Security Among Secondary Students (Class IX to XII), a 3 days' workshop was organised for the "Development of research tools" at CIET-NCERT from 13-15 September 2023. Experts from ISEA-CDAC, I4C- Ministry of Home Affairs, UNESCO, Amrita University, CyberPeace Foundation, AIIMS and facilities from various other Universities were invited for the development of the training package.

In **A study of quality of eContent on DIKSHA and usage patterns and user behaviors**, after preliminary research, the development of the final draft of the research methodology and tools besides the timeline for conducting the research was being undertaken. The first draft of the phase 1 survey questionnaire was prepared. A trial survey to revise and improve the questionnaire was under progress.

Under **Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts at foundational Stage**, scripts for audiovideo programmes were developed in Hindi, English and Urdu. Besides, additional themes for scripts were also identified which would later be produced for dissemination through radio and TV.

Under **Development and Implementation of Curricula for ICT in Education for School Systems based on NEP** -2020, the development of draft competency framework was in process. An online workshop to Review Training Package on 'Development of Online Courses was also organized in September. Besides, a face-to-face workshop was also conducted to review the manuscript of the online Course 'ICT Basics' and Develop Scripts for videos. Identification of course writers for courses on Educational Technology (ET) and ICT was in process. 5 webinars were conducted for capacity building on ET & ICT. An online training on NEP related areas such as Blended Learning was organized in September 2023 wherein 36,412 certificates were issued. Another online training on the theme of 'Developing eContent for Teaching and Learning of Science' was organized and more are planned to be organized in the coming months.

Under Development of Curriculum Based materials of Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) Simulation and 3D videos for School Education, 10 scripts and storyboard were reviewed inhouse and further work was under progress.

Under **Standardization of Indian Sign Language**, follow-up with collaborating organizations was carried out for receiving the feedback on 500 newly developed signs for academic terms, finger spelling for the language spoken in the state, sign names of districts and sign videos for 2785 academic words shared. The 9th ISL Core Committee meeting was also organized in September 2023.

Under **Development and Dissemination of Educational Media Programme for School, Teacher, and Adults Education**, an online review workshop was conducted in July and 10,408 eContent was reviewed as on July. 92 audio programmes and 92 video programmes were produced.

Under **Capacity Building of Teachers and Teacher Educators on Cyber Safety and Security**, a technical review of Online Course on Cyber Safety and Security in Cyberspace was completed. An online training on "Safe Online Communication" was conducted from 03-07 July 2023 in collaboration with CyberPeace Foundation With a total registration of 66,199, Quiz Attempts of 62,938 and Total Certifications at 57,912. An online training on "Internet of Things (IoT) and Mobile security" was conducted from 04-08 September 2023 in collaboration with I4C, Ministry of Home Affairs with a total registration of 63,733, Quiz Attempts of 63334 and Total Certifications at 36,852. A face to face workshop was conducted from 25-27 September to review the Online Course on Cyber Safety and Security in Cyberspace and record the course video. A 3 days Workshop for the "Development Training Package of Cyber Safety and Security for Master Trainers of States/ UTs/ Autonomous Organizations" was held at CIET-


NCERT in which experts from ISEA-CDAC, I4C- Ministry of Home Affairs, UNESCO, Amrita University, CyberPeace Foundation, AIIMS and faculties from various other universities were invited for the development of the training package.

Online Trainings on ET and ICT: 9 online trainings on Educational Technology, ICT, and Cyber Safety were organized between July and September 2023.





In Resource-cum-Activity Centre in ET/ICT for School and Teacher Education, students of University College of London, Manipal University, Jaipur, Manav Rachna International Institute of Research and Studies, Faridabad, Haryana, completed their internship at CIET. - Exposure visit of 21 students from 14 countries participating in Fifth International Programme for Educational Administrators, NIEPA, was scheduled on 28.7.2023. 21 participants of NIEPA 5th IPEA from 14 countries visited CIET facilities. -Visits to the Experiential Learning Center were organized for 5 faculty members of SCERT, Tripura, ~30 members of Forum of Public Schools, Delhi, and 1 Ph.D scholar (Gamification of Science Education) of the Faculty of Education, BHU. -1 Graduate of M.Sc (Biochemistry) from The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda and 2 students of BA (Journalism and Mass Communication), MERI, Janakpuri, Delhi, joined internship at CIET, in PRD and MPD respectively. -1 student of B.Tech (III Year), DTU, Delhi completed his internship and was awarded a certificate for the same. 11 participants of Shri Lal Bahadur Shastri National Sanskrit University, New Delhi visited CIET facilities. - 2 students of Institute of Management Education (IME), Sahibabad, BCA(III Yr) and 1 student of Ram Chameli Chadda Vishvas Girls College in Ghaziabad, B.Com,

joined internship, at CIET, in DICT and Accounts Division respectively. -1 student of Govt. Polytechnic Ghaziabad, Polytechnic (Electronics & Communication Engineering) completed his internship and was awarded a certificate for the same.

Under **Online Publication of Indian Journal of Educational Technology and Quarterly Newsletter of CIET**, the July issue of the journal Indian Journal of Educational Technology was published. Besides, the pending issues of the newsletters were also finalized.

Under Development and Maintenance of Websites, Mobile Apps and Other Digital Activities, to ensure that students received the latest content, regular uploading of most recent NCERT textbooks for upcoming academic sessions was carried out. The team proficiently resolved issues and executed a seamless redirection process for the CIET website, resulting in enhanced user-friendliness and functionality of the CIET website. In order to expand accessibility and outreach, educational videos on various PMeVidya YouTube channels were uploaded, providing learners with effortless access to valuable resources. To ensure enriched learning via flipbooks, flipbooks for DTH Educational TV channel transmission schedules and Journals were uploaded to provide easily accessible program information to users. Collaborations with the SSP Mauritius team were carried out to receive and upload grade-specific videos on their YouTube channel and website. Besides, all 160 Barkha Series Supplementary books were converted to Epub format and uploaded to the server, integrated with the mobile application through Application Programming Interfaces (APIs). Progress was made for creation of APIs for the TSAR iOS and Android app, to enhance functionality. Also, the team was in the developmental phase of the TSAR mobile app, envisioning an exciting learning platform for users.





Figure 3 : Analytics of ePathshala from July to September 2023

In Management of PM e-VIDYA (One Class, One Channel, Radio, Broadcast, Podcasts, the following tasks were carried out in the period :-

- Test run of all 200 PM eVidya DTH TV channels having begun w.e.f. 29th July, 2023, continued with regular scheduling of the telecast of programs by States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies.
- Channels were allocated to States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies and Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MoSDE). Signing MoUs with remaining States and UTs on board was in progress.
- Encoders for live telecast were sent to States for making sessions live. Some States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies had received encoders. These States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies received one encoder each for each channel allocated to them.
- States /UTs Autonomous Bodies created YouTube channels for each PM eVIDYA DTH TV channel allocated to them.
- Content procurement from market was in advanced stage.
- Report of the Dipstick survey was ready.
- Regular meetings of the Academic Advisory Committee were held mainly to deliberate on content procurement.
- A 360-degree Information, Education and Communication (IEC) campaign around this initiative was being planned.
- Activities for planning a 6 phase Capacity Building Program for eContent Developers of PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels had begun.
- An orientation cum training in online mode was successfully conducted for the channel coordinators on 14 September 2023.

PM eVIDYA DTH Live Telecast (Cumulative Record as on 30 September 2023)

- 1. Class 1 to 10 Live programmes: 2,555 Live interactive sessions of 30 minutes each have been telecast on class based channels (1 to 10). It covered about 1,277.5 hours of telecast.
- 2. Class 11 & 12 Live programmes: 254 live interactive sessions of 60 minutes each have been telecast based on class based channels (11 & 12). It covered about 254 hours of telecast.
- 3. SAHYOG: guidance and counselling for mental health and wellbeing of children: 761 live sessions of counselling 'SAHYOG: guidance for mental wellbeing of children' have been transmitted live covering about 380.5 hours.
- 4. Webinar on ICT tools: 787 webinars on ICT tools each for one hours have been telecast for teachers, teacher educators and stakeholders. It covered about 787 hours of telecast.
- 5. Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms: 497 live sessions of 'Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms' have been transmitted live covering about 248.5 hours
- 6. Manodarpan Live interactive sessions : 98 webinar sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #6 to #12 covering 147 hours.

Feedback for PM eVIDYA Channels was received from viewers through email IDs created for each channel and also through Interactive Voice Response System (IVRS).







Figure 5 : IVRS Calls received through IVRS from July to September 2023

Under **Development of Curriculum Based Virtual Labs**, 13 lab manual videos for class 11 were received which were then to be reviewed. Scripts and storyboards for science virtual experiments were received which were then submitted to the scripts committee for review.

Planning was under progress for the organization of eContent Competition for creation of quality digital contents.

In Development of National Curriculum Frameworks – Tech Platform, 12,75,674 DiSaNC responses were recived and 22 State position papers from position papers from West Bengal were received and uploaded besides 4 National District Consultation Reports that were uploaded by Member Secretary of West Bengal National District Group. The National Curriculum Framework for School Education 2023 was uploaded.

Progress was made under **Development of Digital textbooks based on Universal Design of Learning (UDL) "Kitaab ek, Padhe Anek"**. The mapping of two sample chapters, one each from class 1 Hindi textbook Sarangi and Class 1 English Text Book Mridang, was done for tactile points, picture description. The audio recording of the text in desired chunks was done and recording in ISL was also started.

Under **Continuous Professional Development (CPD) through NISHTHA - Educational Technology**, the following progress was made:-

Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (15 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 Community Radio Stations), 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps.
