One of our significant undertakings, the study on the Effectiveness of PM e-Vidya Video Content on Students' Achievement at the Secondary Level, is progressing well. We are in the midst of constructing a robust research tool to assess this initiative's impact. Concurrently, our deep dive into the effectiveness of AR and VR content in Science and Mathematics continues, aiming to bring innovative solutions to educational challenges.

Under **PM eVidya DIKSHA – One Nation One Platform**, the Average daily page hits were 69 lakh + ; 6179 textbooks were energized by States/UTs and were available on DIKSHA including 494 ETBs of NCERT (incl.366 + 26 BhashaSangam and 102 Comic books) , class 1&2 Maths textbook in English ,Hindi,Urdu and in 20 regional language and 3,50,485 eContent were available on DIKSHA in 84 languages (77 Indian languages +7 Foreign Languages).Designing of Training Manual on **‘Development of Online Courses’** is in process 43rd and 44th **DIKSHA Monthly Coordination Meeting** held on April 25 and May 29, 2024 respectively.

### Virtual labs vertical on DIKSHA

280 science experiments are uploaded on DIKSHA , for which No. of Plays are 1,69,888 and minutes of engagement are 2,14,724.

### eContent for CWSN

4,707 audiobook chapters have been developed and uploaded on DIKSHA and 954 textbook-based ISL videos have been uploaded on DIKSHA.

## FLN vertical on DIKSHA

2,778 resources have been uploaded for FLN vertical, for which no. of plays are 5,39,973 and minutes of engagement are 4,17,918.

## Education For All Vertical on DIKSHA

1,107 resources and 4 primers and 1 jingle on vertical have been uploaded, for which, no. of plays are 35,604 and minutes of engagement are 47,617.

## Vocational Education vertical on DIKSHA

Total no. of e-contents available on DIKSHA are 877, for which no. of plays are 10,549 and minutes of engagement are 27,384.

## CPD courses on DIKSHA

Four generic CPD courses are offered through DIKSHA for which, total **Enrolments** are 3,45,805, total **Consumption** is 1,81,512 and total **Certifications** are 1,47,817.

The development of Inclusive and Equitable Education vertical on DIKSHA is going on.

Under **PM eVidya Development of Curriculum Based AR/VR and Virtual labs**, In the recent efforts to advance AR development and virtual labs, a significant milestone was achieved with the finalization of 50 titles each in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Mathematics. In May, online training for Virtual Labs was scheduled to further support this initiative. On June 4, 2024, an online meeting was conducted to review and update the status of Virtual Labs across various subjects. The process of onboarding Olabs for Science, Mathematics, Languages, and Social Studies onto the DIKSHA Virtual Labs platform via VidyaDaan was also facilitated. In April, the organization of workshops was initiated, with two online meetings held to expedite the uploading process of Olabs through **VidyaDaan**.

Under **PM eVidya Organization of Festival, ICT Mela, contests of digital contents and coordination with States/ UTs**, the archival record for AICEeCC 2023–24 has been created on the official website of CIET. And the constitution of the jury panel for AICEeCC 2024–25 is in process, for which an exhaustive list of experts in children’s digital media is being curated.

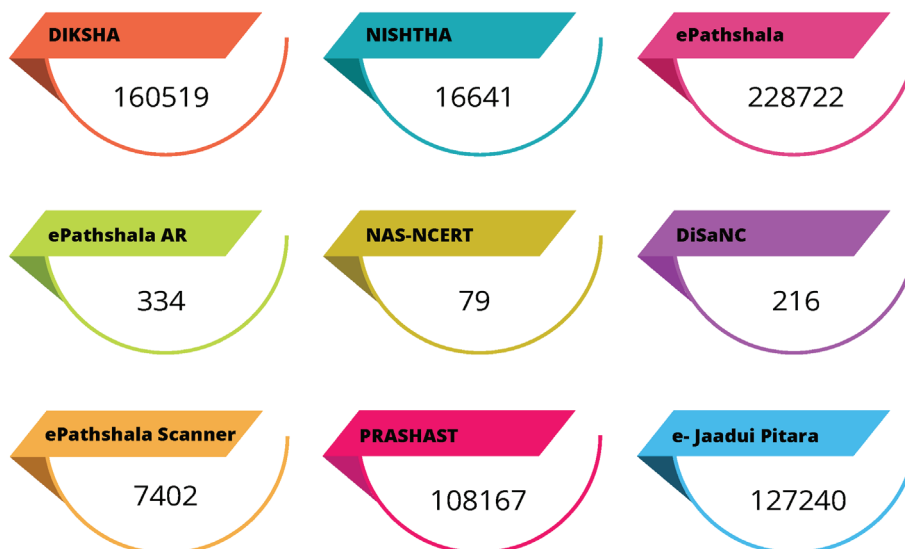
Under **Development and Maintenance of Websites, Mobile Apps and Other Digital Activities**, following activities are undertaken:

1. Up-to-date NCERT Textbooks: We ensure students receive the latest content by regularly uploading the most recent NCERT textbooks for upcoming academic sessions.
2. Revamped and Enhanced NCERT, CIET and Diksha Website: Our team proficiently resolved issues and maintained regular uploading for the NCERT & CIET website, resulting in enhanced user-friendliness and functionality.
3. Youtube uploading: We regularly upload the most recent video content on youtube, in April month we have uploaded 72 videos and 37 audio of class 1 to 3 based on NCERT Textbooks.
4. Flipbook and QR code creation and integration of class 3 based on NCERT Textbooks and bridge courses.
5. Addressing Vulnerabilities, Ensuring User Protection: Our team proactively rectifies vulnerabilities in the OSRE website and Prashast mobile app, reinforcing security and protecting user information.
6. Language Translations: Language translations for 22 different languages of Anand Unmukh, Barkha Series. Translation of ECCE & FLN documents for Nishtha. Also regularly translated for Continuous Professional Development (CPD), posters and bookmarks.
7. Creative Banner Design: We have designed various banners and logos, ensuring consistency across platforms such as mobile apps, websites.
8. Social Media: We have posted different topics relevant to NCERT, e.g. e-Jaaduyi Pitara, Swayam, Webinars, Rashtriya ePustakalaya, Diskha, live post etc. For getting more engagement from netizens. Apart from above following activities are also taken up.

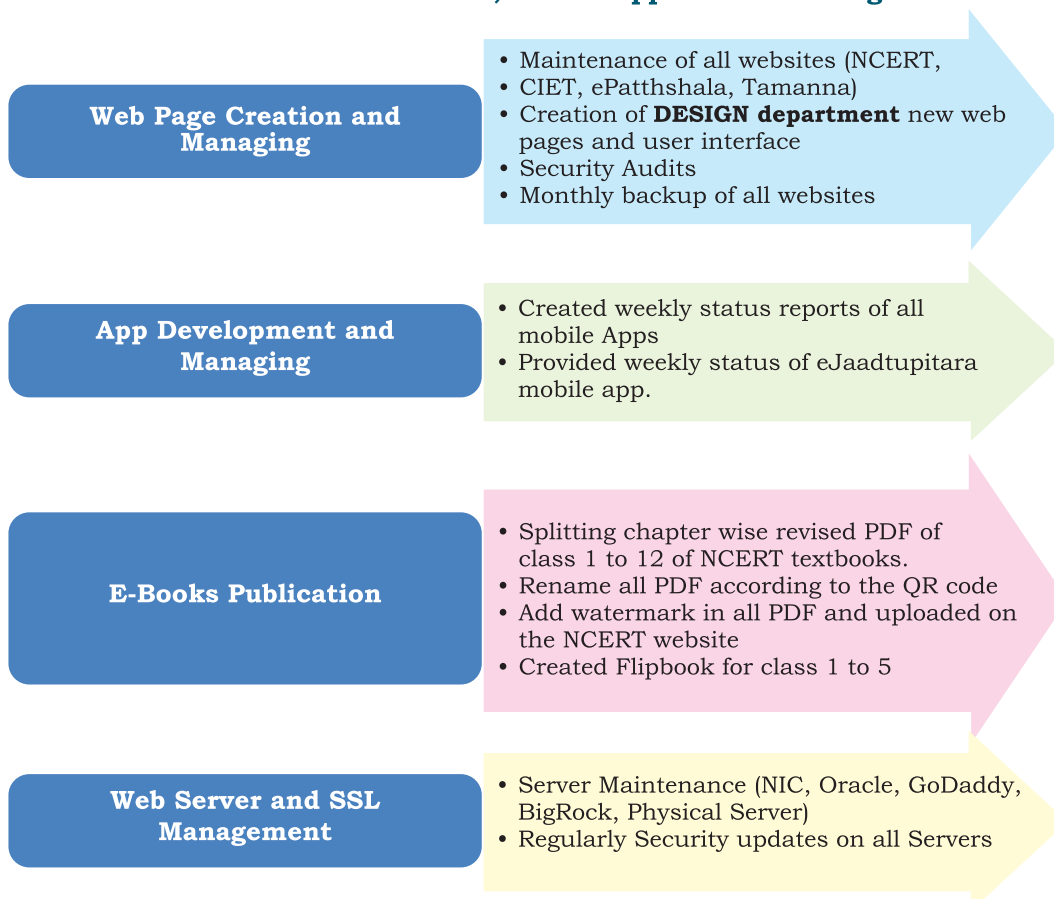
**Figure 1: Number of visitors on websites till June 2024**

## DHE, MoE FUNDED

Under the initiative, **Development of SWAYAM MOOCs on School Education**, In April, 383 certificates were released for Cycle 12 across 28 courses, which included 152 Course Completion Certificates, 114 Course Appreciation Certificates, and 117 Course Participation Certificates. Additionally, 28 courses for Class XI and XII were launched under Cycle 13, with total enrollments reaching 11,972 by May 2, 2024. Report writing, including data analysis and data interpretation for Cycle 12, was in progress during this month.

In May, the same 28 courses saw enrollments increase to 24,199 by May 2, 2024. Report writing for Cycle 12 was completed. Several significant events were organized, including a Planning Meet with an autonomous organization on May 20, 2024, a Consultation Meeting on MOOCs on SWAYAM on May 21, 2024, and a Workshop for Course Coordinators of MOOCs on SWAYAM on May 28-29, 2024. The minutes of the meetings held on May 20 and May 21 were finalized, as was the report on the workshop held on May 28-29. Certificates were released to all participants of the workshop. Additionally, reports for Cycles 9, 10, 11, and 12 on MOOCs for school education on the SWAYAM portal were reviewed.

By June 21, 2024, total enrollments across the 28 courses for Cycle 13 had reached 28,932.

## Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA venture also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (17 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 CommunityRadio Stations), 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps. Till end of this quarter, 4,028 pieces of curriculum-based radio programmes (Classes 1-12) were disseminated for broadcast and 2,757 Live Programs were broadcast through iRadio and JioSaavn apps. Not only this, the following activities were undertaken through Community Radio and Podcast.

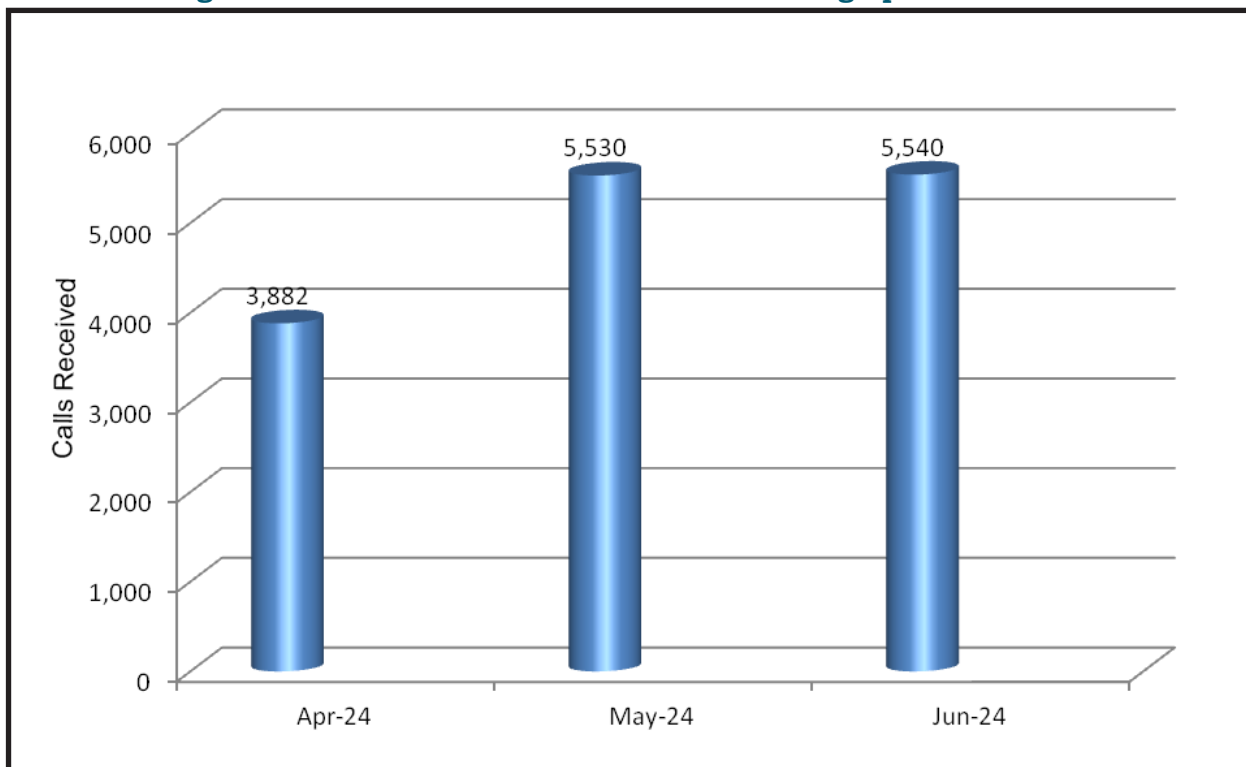

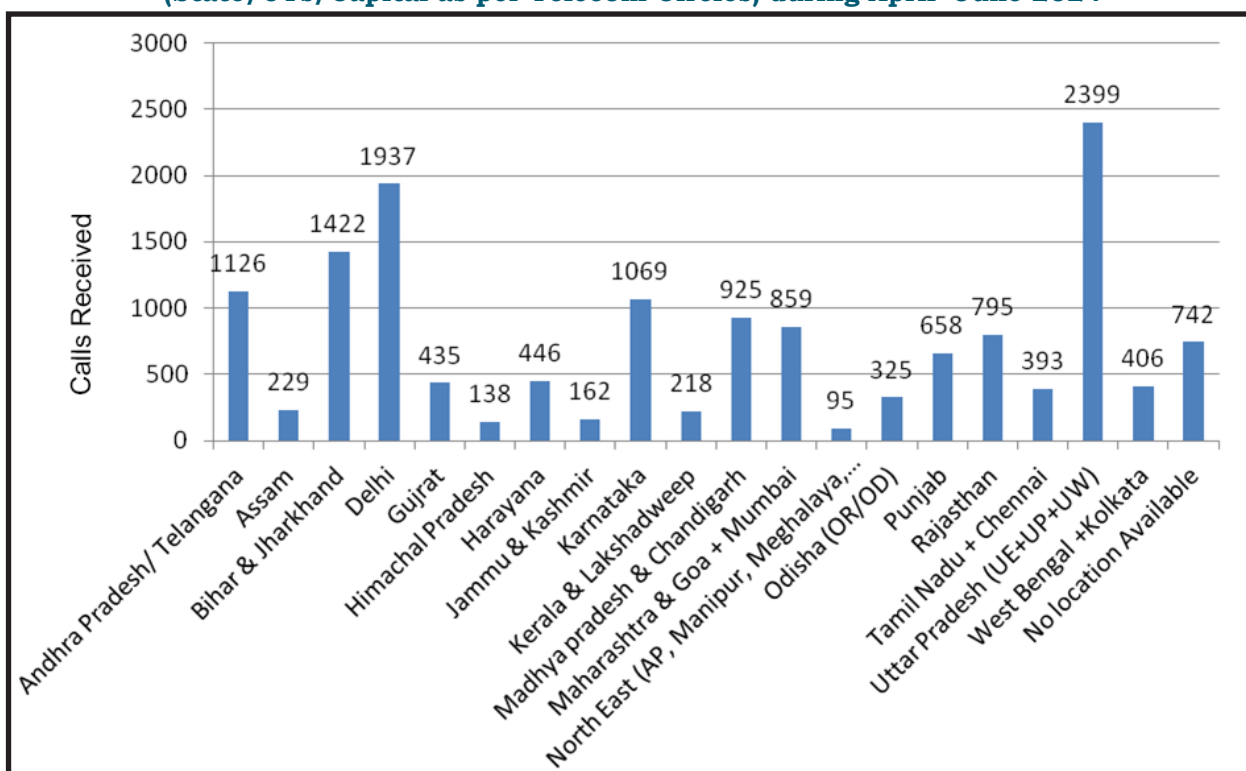

**Figure-5: Statewise calls received through PM eVIDYA IVR System (State/UTs/Capital as per Telecom Circles) during April- June 2024**



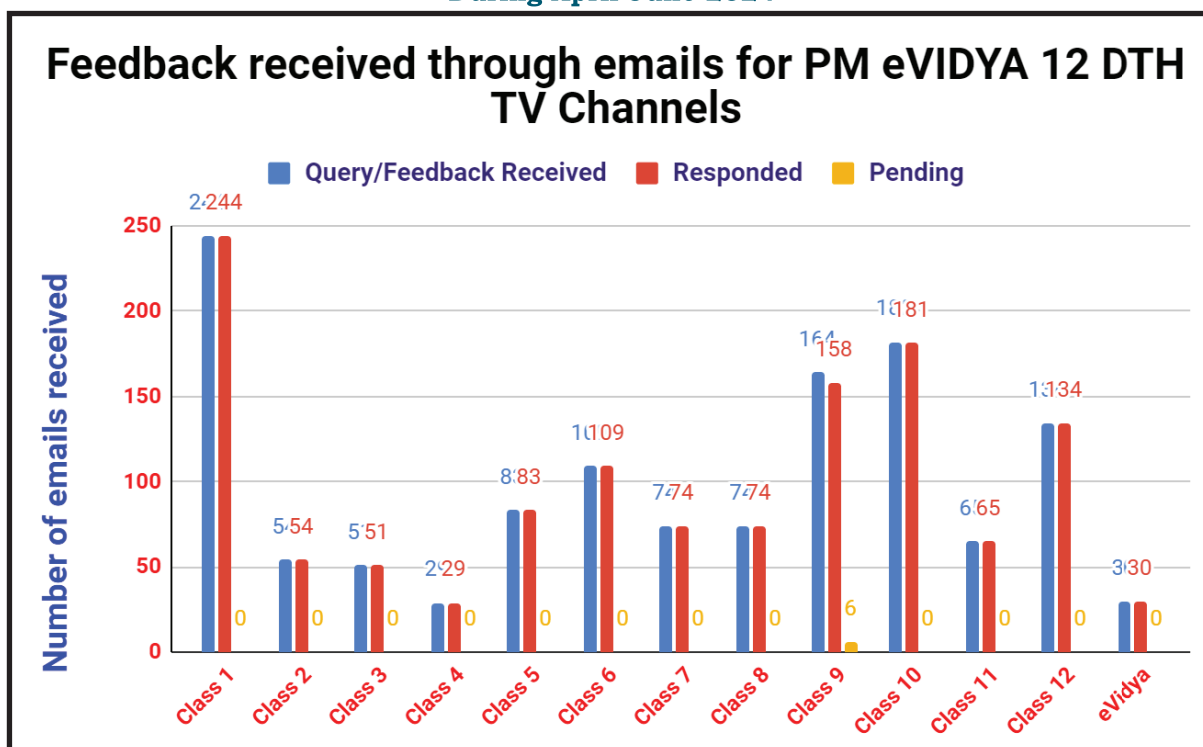

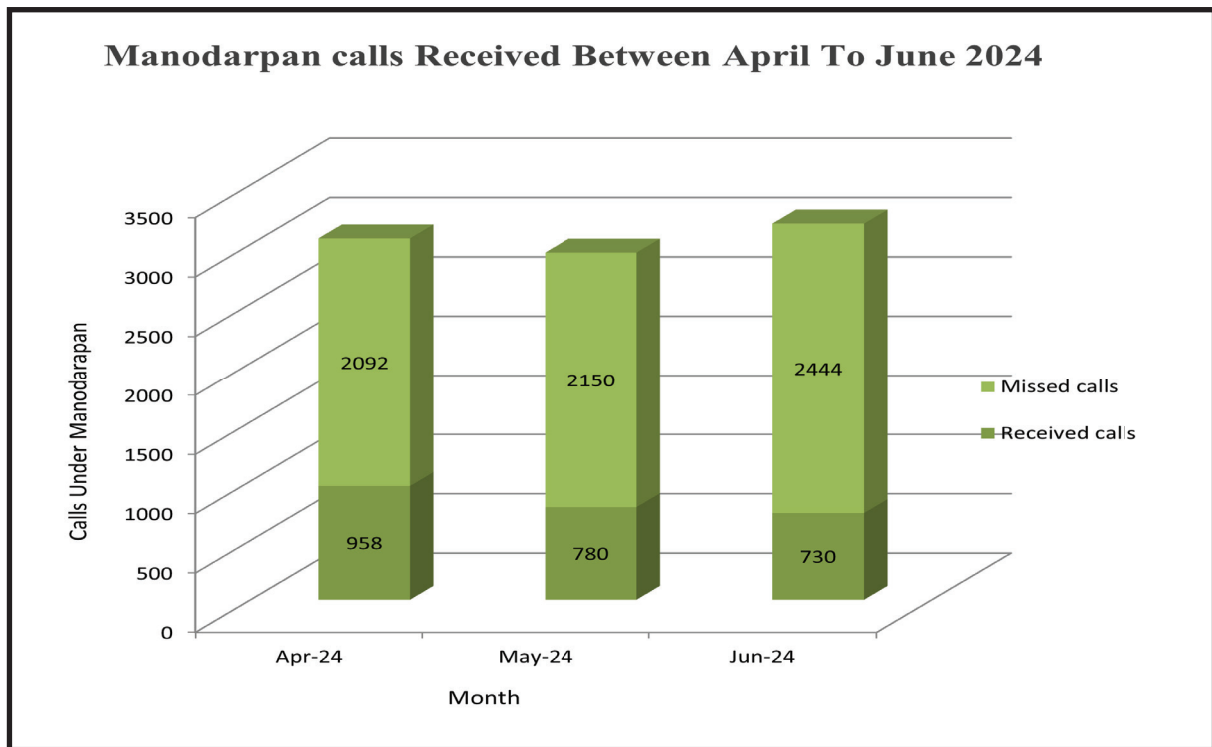

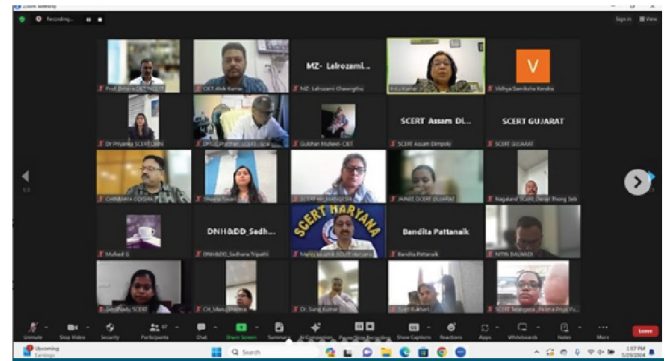
