CIET has been a premier institution working for the technological interventions in education for school and teacher education. Being the last quarter of the financial year, January-March witnessed important events at CIET related to the different projects that have been undertaken for betterment of school education.

The 40th meeting of Institutional Advisory Board (IAB) of CIET was held on 23 January, 2024 wherein the proposals of both current financial year and those of the upcoming one (2024-2025) were discussed and deliberated upon by members.

The launch of PM eVidya 200 DTH TV channels, one of our flagship initiatives, was done on 9th March 2024 by the Honorable Education Minister of India.

The flagship All India Children's Educational eContent Competition (AICEeCC 2023-24) was held on 15-16 March, 2024 at North East Regional Institute of Education (NERIE) Shillong. Professor P.S.Shukla, the Vice Chancellor of North Eastern Hill University (NEHU), Shillong inaugurated the event which also saw Shri Rakkam A. Sangma, Minister of Education, Government of Meghalaya as the chief guest for the valedictory ceremony on 16.03.2024.

To strengthen educational technology and ICT in education for school systems, webinars and online training sessions were organized. CIET continued promotion of cyber safety and security among teachers and teacher educators by organizing webinars in the aforementioned quarter. Various audio video programmes were also produced for dissemination among schools, teachers and adults. The January, 2024 issue of the Indian Journal of Educational Technology was also published. CIET continued its focus on the development of Digital textbooks based on Universal Design of Learning (UDL) during this quarter. A workshop was organized in offline mode for the Accessible Feature Mapping of Mathematics book of class I in Hindi and English medium by experts.

It is our endeavor to keep our stakeholders updated about the diverse activities for educational technology that are being undertaken by our organization.

Under the study of Feedback towards PM e-Vidya Program of Teachers and Students across the country, data for feedback was collected from Assam, Odisha, Jammu and Kashmir from over 60 schools and is now under process.

In the project on Effectiveness of Techno-Pedagogy Content Integration (TPCI) package on development of Digital Competencies of Inservice teachers at secondary level, online workshops for the revision of the TPCI 01 Module, development of the TPCI 02 module and its subsequent review were organized. Also, training sessions on Techno-Pedagogy Content Integration on ICT- Basic and ICT-Pedagogy Integration were conducted in face to face and online mode.

Under the Study of the Awareness on Cyber safety and Security Among Secondary Students (Class IX to XII), Cyber Safety and Security Students' handbook was reviewed by resource persons. Besides, Cyber Safety and Security Awareness Scale (CSSAS) for Secondary Students was translated in Hindi. In addition to this, a workshop was organized wherein a cyber safety and security intervention package containing students' modules and activities for secondary students were developed by experts.

Under Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts for classes 1 & 2, workshops were organized wherein scripts in both Hindi and English were developed.

Under the collaborative efforts of CIET-NCERT and MoEF&CC, The "Wetlands: Our Amrit Dharohar" video series, produced by CIET under NCERT and DOSEL, Ministry of Education, in collaboration with MoEFCC, was launched on World Wetlands Day 2024 at Sirpur Lake, Indore, Madhya Pradesh. The event featured Dr. Mohan Yadav, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, Shri Ashwini Kumar Choubey, Hon'ble Minister of State for Environment, Forest & Climate Change, and Dr. Musonda Mumba, Secretary General of the Ramsar Convention on Wetlands. This series aims to raise awareness among school students about the importance of wetlands, their ecosystem services, and sustainable use. Wetlands are vital for global economies, freshwater provision, biodiversity enrichment, and climate adaptation and mitigation. The series encourages students to feel connected to nature and view wetlands as essential to their lives. Designed for different educational stages—Preparatory, Middle, and Secondary—the videos are accessible on DIKSHA (diksha.gov.in), the NCERT OFFICIAL YouTube channel, and PM eVidya DTH TV channels. Knowledge partners like GIZ, Wetlands International South Asia, WWF India, and SES, JNU have significantly contributed to the educational initiative's depth and impact.

Under the study of quality of eContent on DIKSHA and usage patterns and user behaviours, questionnaires in both English and Hindi were developed which were then used to collect data. The data collected was also under process of being analyzed.

Under Development and Implementation of Curricula for ICT in Education for School systems based on NEP 2020, 13 webinars for developing capacity on ET & ICT were organized and 7 online trainings were organized. More details of activities undertaken in it are presented in Table 3.

Under Development of Curriculum Based materials of Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) Simulation and 3D videos in science for School Education, a 2 days training workshop by RWIZEN-SARD was organized to train CIET staff on the above mentioned themes., besides analysis of storyboards and scripts.

Under **Standardization of Indian Sign Language**, two workshops were organized for the validation of signs of approximately 103 ISL words, district names, finger spellings in different languages that were received from state organizations in virtual mode. 13 Experts from the deaf community were invited to validate ISL words received from state organizations. They focused on standardizing ISL words, fingerspelling, and district names, while also providing feedback on 514 academic terms.

Under Development and Dissemination of Educational Media Programmes for School, Teachers and Adults, various audio and video programmes were produced, details of which are presented in Table 4 and Table 5 respectively.

Under Online Publication of Indian Journal of Educational Technology and Quarterly Newsletter of CIET, the Volume 6 (January 2024) issue of the journal IJET was published. Articles were also being vetted for the upcoming July issue of the journal. Meanwhile newsletters till the October-December 2023 quarter were published online and work was underway for the ongoing quarter.


Work was carried out under Development and Maintenance of Websites, Mobile Apps and Other Digital Activities as well. The following tasks were completed under this:

- Translation of Anand Unmukh mathematics books in multiple languages for class 1 and 2.
- Language Translations: Language translations for NDL and Jaadui Pitara mobile app in 23 different languages. Also regularly translated for Continuous Professional Development (CPD), posters and bookmarks.
- Bhartiya Bhasha Utsav Portal: Bhartiya Bhasha Utsav Portal was regularly maintained to submit weekly activity reports and it received a total 8453 entries across India.
- Flipbook Creation and Integration: NCERT textbooks were converted into flipbook format and uploaded to the ePathshala website.
- Website hosted on NIC: Four application portal and one website were hosted on NIC server e.g. Doctoral Fellowship, Action Research, Research Associateship, Research Methodology and Kala UTSAV.
- Social Media: different topics relevant to NCERT, e.g. PPC 2024, Jaadui Pitara, Swayam, Webinars rsvp live post etc. were posted regularly on social media for getting more engagement from netizens.

Under PM eVidya Management of 200 DTH TV channels and Radio Broadcasts and Podcast, the following progress was made:

- PM eVIDYA 200 DTH TV Channels Initiative formally launched by Hon'ble Union Minister of Education, Government of India on 9 March 2024 at Kaushal Bhawan, New Delhi, continues with regular telecast of educational video programs by States/UTs/Autonomous Bodies.
- Under PM eVidya 200 DTH TV Channels initiative, 27 States, 07 UTs, and 06 Autonomous Bodies (AB) are contributing with 35432, 5461 and 16830 numbers of eContent respectively.
- A total of 57723 numbers of video content equal to 19696 hours of telecast has been received from States/UTs/ABs across the country in 27 languages till March.
- A total number of 184 program schedules received from the 27 States, 7 UTs, and 6 ABs for the month of April 2024.




Figure 4: IVRS Calls from January to March 2024

- A total number of 81 YouTube channels are live for simulcast of the PM eVidya DTH TV Channels of 12 States, 4 UTs and 5 ABs. Figure 4 showcases the live YouTube channels for respective States/Union territories/Autonomous Bodies.
- A visit to CIET, NCERT by officials from National Instructional Media Institute (NIMI), MoSDE was held in connection with PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels.
- An online meeting to discuss the non-visibility of PM eVidya DTH TV channels via Free Dish in Manipur was organized wherein the issues related to accessibility of PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels among the public in Manipur were addressed.
- A visit to CIET, NCERT by Director General (DG) of the Directorate General of Training(DGT), under the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship(MoSDE) and other officials from National Instructional Media Institute (NIMI), MoSDE was held in February in connection with PM eVIDYA DTH TV Channels.

PMeVidya DTH-TV Live telecast (as on 31 March 2024) Cumulative records:

- Class 1 to 10 Live programmes: 2,555 Live interactive sessions of 30 minutes each have been telecast on class based channels (1 to 10). It covered about 1,277.5 hours of telecast.
- Class 11 & 12 Live programmes: 254 live interactive sessions of 60 minutes each have been telecast based on class based channels (11 & 12). It covered about 254 hours of telecast.
- SAHYOG: guidance and counseling for mental health and wellbeing of children: 761 live sessions of counseling 'SAHYOG: guidance for mental wellbeing of children' have been transmitted live covering about 380.5 hours.
- Webinar on ICT tools: 787 webinars on ICT tools each for one hour have been telecast for teachers, teacher educators and stakeholders. It covered about 787 hours of telecast.
- Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms: 497 live sessions of Teaching Learning Interventions for Inclusive Classrooms' have been transmitted live covering about 248.5 hours
- Manodarpan Live interactive sessions: 98 webinar sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #6 to #12 covering 147 hours.
- Live interactive sessions on National Student Outreach Program, Listening to Learn (Science & Technology): 51 Live interactive sessions have been transmitted on PM eVidya channels #10 to 12 covering 51 hours.
- Live interactive sessions on School Leadership in collaboration with NCSL, NIEPA: 79 Live interactive sessions have been transmitted on PMeVidya channels #06, 09 & 12 covering 39.5 hours



Feedback Mechanism

Feedback for PM eVIDYA Channels was received from viewers through email IDs created for each channel and also through calls made to Interactive Voice Response System (IVRS). Figure 4 details the total calls received in the months of January, February and March respectively on the IVRs number. A total of 10,681 calls were received with 3455 calls in January 2024, 3291 calls in February 2024 and 3935 calls in March 2024.

Figure 5 details the class-wise queries received on the email addresses of PM eVidya that have been created for each class separately. A total of 1259 emails have been received till date.




Figure 6: State-wise calls received on PM eVidya from January to March

Figure 6 explains the calls received according to the states/telecom circles in India between the months of January and March. A total of 10,681 calls were received from all over India.





Figure 7: Calls received under the Manodarpan initiative from January to March

Figure 7 comprises the calls received under the Manodarpan initiative. A total of 3200 calls were received between January and March 2024.

Under Organization of Festival, ICT Mela, contests of digital contents and coordination with States/ UTs, a total of 727 entries were received till 30th January 2024 for All India Children's Educational eContent Competition (AICEeCC 2023-24), after which the two day event was held on 15-16 March, 2024 at North East Regional Institute of Education (NERIE) Shillong. 75 awards in total were distributed in different categories, of media type, producing agency, and learning levels.

Under the **Development of National Curriculum Frameworks – Tech Platform,** all twenty-five State Positions Papers e-templates were submitted by 28 states. Also, 12,77,353 DiSaNC responses till February 2024 were received

Under **Development of Digital textbooks based on Universal Design of Learning (UDL) Kitaab ek, Padhe Anek, a** three-day workshop was organized from 7th February to 09th February 2024 in offline mode for the Accessible Feature Mapping of Mathematics book of class I in Hindi and English medium. Experts discussed and explored ways to energize the Mathematics books of class I and thus, three chapters of the Mathematics Book of Class I in Hindi and English medium were mapped for accessibility features.



Community Radio and Podcast

PM eVIDYA also offers educational e-contents (especially audio programmes) on radio platforms; both traditional radio e. g. FM as well as online radio e. g. podcast. Radio and podcast are aimed to serve the children lacking proper ICT infrastructure. The dissemination/broadcast of these programs is done on 401 Radio Stations (15 GyanVani FM Radio Stations, 254 Community Radio Stations, 132 All India Radio stations) and Podcasts on iRadio and JioSaavn Mobile apps.
