It is with great enthusiasm that we bring to you this edition of our newsletter, showcasing strides in inclusive education and digital transformation. The past months have been a testament to our commitment to fostering an educational ecosystem that prioritizes accessibility, equity, and innovation, aligning with the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

A key highlight in this journey has been the five-day online training on Specific Learning Disability (SLD)-Friendly Classrooms, held from October 14 to 18, 2024, to mark Dyslexia Awareness Week. This initiative addressed the growing need to integrate SLD-friendly practices into our classrooms. With over 42,000 registrations and interactive sessions telecast live on PM eVIDYA DTH channels and digital platforms, this training equipped educators with strategies to support students with specific learning disabilities such as dyslexia. Themes covered included inclusive teaching techniques for English, Hindi, Social Science, Mathematics, and EVS, delivered in bilingual format (Hindi and English) and supported by Indian Sign Language (ISL) interpreters. This effort underscores our dedication to ensuring no learner is left behind, while also empowering educators to create inclusive learning spaces.

Another landmark development was the launch of PM e-VIDYA DTH Channel No. 31, exclusively dedicated to ISL, on December 6, 2024. This 24x7 channel represents a revolutionary step in breaking communication barriers for Children with Special Needs (CwSN). Inaugurated by the Hon'ble Union Minister for Education, Shri Dharmendra Pradhan, this channel delivers curriculum-aligned content, teacher training resources, career guidance, and mental health support, all in ISL. It sets a benchmark for inclusivity while promoting ISL as a vital communication tool and cultural heritage. This initiative exemplifies our nation's commitment to creating a progressive society and building opportunities for all, especially for the differently-abled.

Beyond inclusivity, our efforts have continued in the digital sphere, with impactful developments across web portals, mobile apps, MOOCs, and eBooks. The launch of dynamic event portals like "Bhasha Ghar" and "Bharat on the Moon," as well as the development of chatbot solutions, reflect our dedication to improving user experiences and outreach. We are also thrilled to report significant progress in SWAYAM MOOCs, where enrollment in Cycle 14 has seen remarkable growth across 28 courses for Classes XI and XII.

The success of these initiatives would not have been possible without the unwavering support of educators, stakeholders, and learners nationwide. Together, we are redefining education as a space that embraces diversity and empowers every learner to reach their full potential.

RESEARCH

Under the study titled as **Effectiveness of PM e-Vidya Video content on Student’s achievement at Secondary Level**, meetings with local coordinators were held to ensure the successful implementation of the first phase, which has now commenced at all sites, including KV Sec-2 RK Puram. Budget allocations for RIEs were processed to support research, while pre-test data checking and entry are ongoing. Monitoring of the intervention plan is in progress, with coordination among teachers and faculty for video screenings and data updates in selected RIEs, DM Schools, and KVS. The introduction chapter is being finalized to align with program objectives, alongside a comprehensive review of literature covering similar past studies. Efforts continue to streamline data handling and ensure effective execution of the intervention plan.

Under the study titled as **Effectiveness of AR and VR Content on Students' Learning Outcomes in Science and Mathematics at Secondary Level**, an in-house meeting was held on October 23–24, 2024, to review project progress and address challenges in selecting AR content for experimentation. Drafts of the tools were discussed and reviewed during the meeting. A three-day workshop for tool finalization was conducted from December 9–11, 2024. Two tools, the Reaction Scale and the Achievement Test, were finalized during the workshop. These efforts aim to enhance the project's methodology and experimentation process.

DEVELOPMENT

Development of Educational Audio/Video Programme Scripts for School, Teacher, and Adult Education, the five-day online training on **Specific Learning Disability-Friendly Classrooms** (October 14–18, 2024) by CIET, NCERT, focused on inclusive education as outlined in NEP 2020 and RPWD Act 2016. Conducted live on DTH TV channels and YouTube, the bilingual sessions with Indian Sign Language interpreters saw 42,453 registrations, 4,604 quiz participants, and 4,194 certifications. On December 6, 2024, the **PM e-VIDYA DTH Channel No. 31** was launched, dedicated to Indian Sign Language (ISL) for curriculum content, teacher training, and career guidance, inaugurated by Education Minister Shri Dharmendra Pradhan. This milestone highlights India's commitment to accessible and inclusive education for learners with diverse needs.

TRAINING

Under the programme, **Development of Digital Resources on Cyber Safety and Capacity Building**, From October to December 2024, multiple online training sessions and micro-courses were launched on the DIKSHA portal in collaboration with organizations like CyberPeace Foundation, ISEA-CDAC, and I4C. These included courses on Social Media Safety and Well-being, Secure Practices for Digital Gaming, and Internet of Things (IoT) Safety, offered in both English and Hindi. Enrollments and certifications for ongoing courses such as Cyber Threats, Digital Wellness, Financial Safety, and Cyber Parenting have shown consistent growth. Notable participation was observed, with enrollments exceeding 100,000 for Cyber Threats in English. These initiatives aim to enhance digital literacy and cybersecurity awareness.

EXTENSION

In Online Publication of Indian Journal of Educational Technology and Quarterly Newsletter of CIET, an online workshop for configuring the Open Journal System (OJS) was conducted from October 11–20, 2024, as part of the ongoing efforts to enhance the Indian Journal of Educational Technology (IJET). Additionally, the third-quarter edition of the newsletter has been compiled and is uploaded, ensuring timely dissemination of updates and information.

The achievements and activities of the **“PM eVidya DIK SHA – One Nation One Platform”** are From October to December 2024, significant progress was made in enhancing the DIKSHA platform, including content cleaning exercises, new vertical launches, and the selection of AI models for advanced features like “Chat with Book.” The RVSK initiative expanded with 32 operational VSKs and preparations for a National VSK Conference in February 2025. Dashboard updates for PRASHAST, APAAR, and PM POSHAN were enhanced with role-based authentication and analytics. Quizzes on diverse themes and CPD courses continued to engage users, while website and security enhancements ensured improved functionality and compliance. Coordination meetings and collaborations with stakeholders further streamlined processes and facilitated operational readiness.

Under the project titled as “**PM eVidya Development of Curriculum Based AR/VR and Virtual labs**”, a total of 25 Virtual Lab live sessions were conducted by NCERT YouTube Channel and PMeVidya DTH Channel. Four VR environments and 10 scripts/storyboards for Science and Mathematics (classes 9–12) were developed, alongside progress in setting up Virtual Labs in four DM schools.

VIRTUAL LAB LIVE SESSIONS

Live Sessions Conducted:

- 11 Virtual Lab live sessions were conducted via NCERT YouTube Channel and PMeVidya
- DTH Channel. 14 additional Virtual Lab live sessions were conducted on the same platforms

Development of Scripts and Storyboards

- 4 model scripts and storyboards in Science and Mathematics were approved by the script committee.
- 10 scripts and storyboards were developed in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Mathematics, covering classes 9–12.

Creation of Virtual Reality Environments

- Four Virtual Reality (VR) environments were developed for Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Mathematics.
- One virtual lab simulation in Chemistry was created.

Virtual Lab Setup in DM Schools

- The setup of Virtual Labs in four Demonstration Multipurpose (DM) Schools is in progress, with civil and electrical work initiated.

Collaboration and Content Sharing

- A review report of 28 OLABs experiments was shared with the OLABs team.
- 4 new OLABs experiments were uploaded to DIKSHA Virtual Labs.

Under the initiative titled as “**PM eVidya Organization of Festival, ICT Mela, contests of digital contents and coordination with States/ UTs**”, the competition was announced on October 10, 2024, inviting entries from education and media stakeholders, with orientation programs conducted in October and December, including one for Puducherry attended by ~250 teachers. Advertisements in 27 national dailies and social media posts in Hindi and English helped promote participation. By December 2024, 206 entries (122 videos, 62 audios, and 22 eContent) had been received, alongside 6 earlier entries in November. The submission deadline has been extended to January 15, 2025.

The **PM e-Vidya Continuous Professional Development (CPD)** initiative under **NISHTHA Educational Technology** aims to enhance teachers' digital competencies through structured training. It offers Level 1 and Level 2 courses focusing on leveraging digital tools, ICT integration, and pedagogical innovations aligned with NEP 2020. Figure 1 : Number of Visitors on Website till December 2024

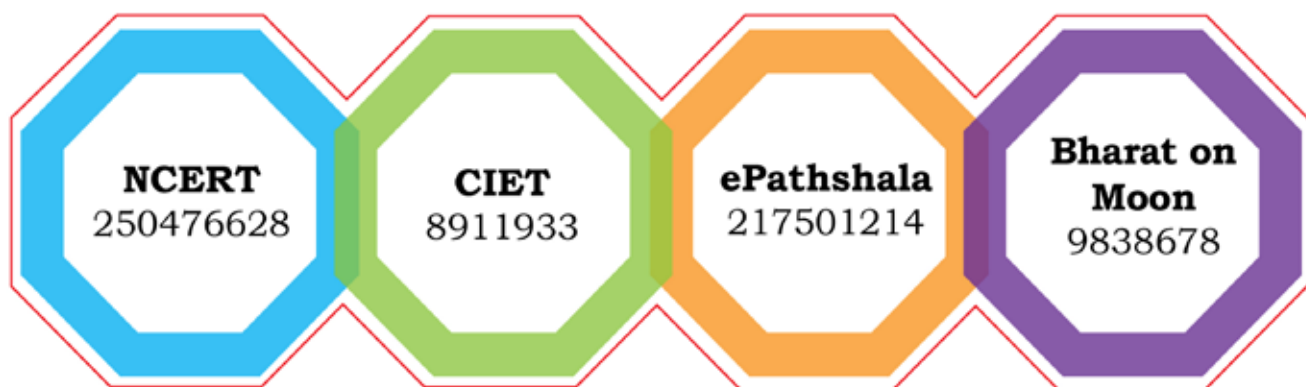
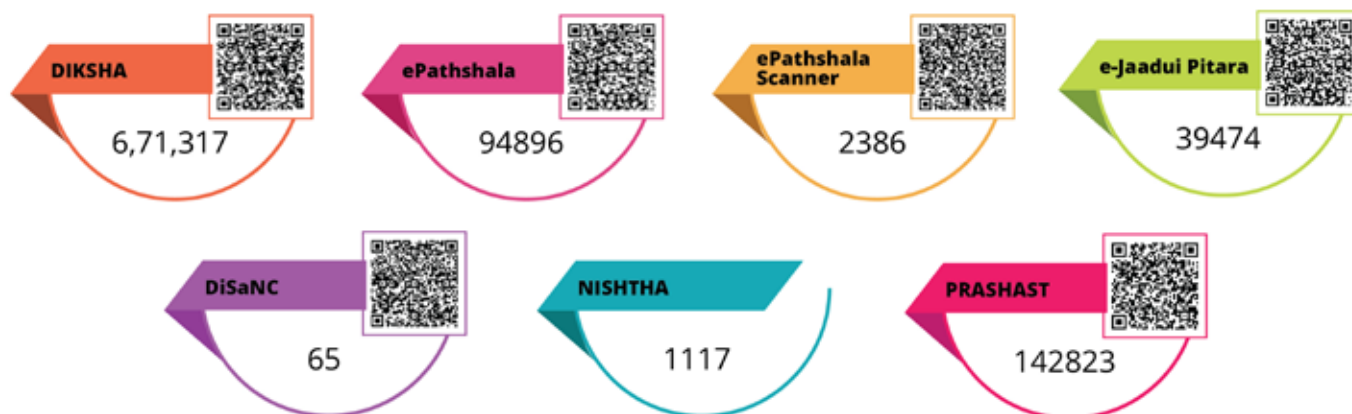


Figure 2 : Mobile Apps with Installed Audience between October - December 2024



PRASHAST

PRASHAST (Pre Assessment Holistic Screening Tool) launched on 6th September 2022. This screening tool covers the 21 disabilities as per the RPWD Act 2016 and is one of its kind statistically standardized screening tool for disabilities at the school level which promoted participation of regular and special teachers in the screening process. Consequent to a number of queries received on IVRS number and the PRASHAST helpdesk email regarding registration, account verification, and usage of the PRASHAST App from stakeholders pan India, six orientation programs (four online and two offline session) for the PRASHAST App was conducted during October to December 2024. The details are mentioned below –

Under the initiative of “ **Development of SWAYAM MOOCs on School Education**” the transition between Cycle 13 and Cycle 14 reflects a continued focus on expanding course offerings and improving engagement in MOOCs for school education, enrollment trends show significant growth, emphasizing increased adoption and reach of SWAYAM initiatives for Class XI and XII students. **Cycle 14** (October 16, 2024, to March 25, 2025) marked a new phase with enrollment for 28 courses spanning 11 subjects, including Accountancy, Business Studies, Economics, Geography, Sociology, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Psychology, and English. Initially, enrollment stood at 1,627 as of October 30, 2024, which rose to 7,042 by November 28, 2024, and further increased to 8,725 by December 18, 2024. The total enrollment across all courses reached 3,252 by the end of October 2024. Efforts to prepare detailed individual course reports from Cycle 13 were completed to draw insights for Cycle 14.

These activities highlight the growing adoption and impact of SWAYAM’s MOOCs for school education, showcasing consistent efforts to expand course offerings and engage learners more effectively.

Community Radio and Podcast

Radio programs contains mainly the programs based on some of the chapters of the new NCERT textbooks in which songs on nation, science quiz for younger groups, short tribal and folk stories

from different parts of Bharat, inclusive education and environmental awareness etc. are included.

Moreover, Program contains a segment in which short information about scheduled languages of India, states of India, continents; NEP etc. are given followed by the questions. Sizeable numbers of listeners do respond to the questions.

Umang broadcast 5 days a week from different radio stations of All India Radio across the country.

A good feedback is received in response to the broadcast to NCERT through e mail and IVRS phone calls. Umang program has made a good impact among blind listeners. Umang has also made impact on school teachers.

Audio programmes are also being shared with Community Radio Stations and IGNOU Gyanvani stations.

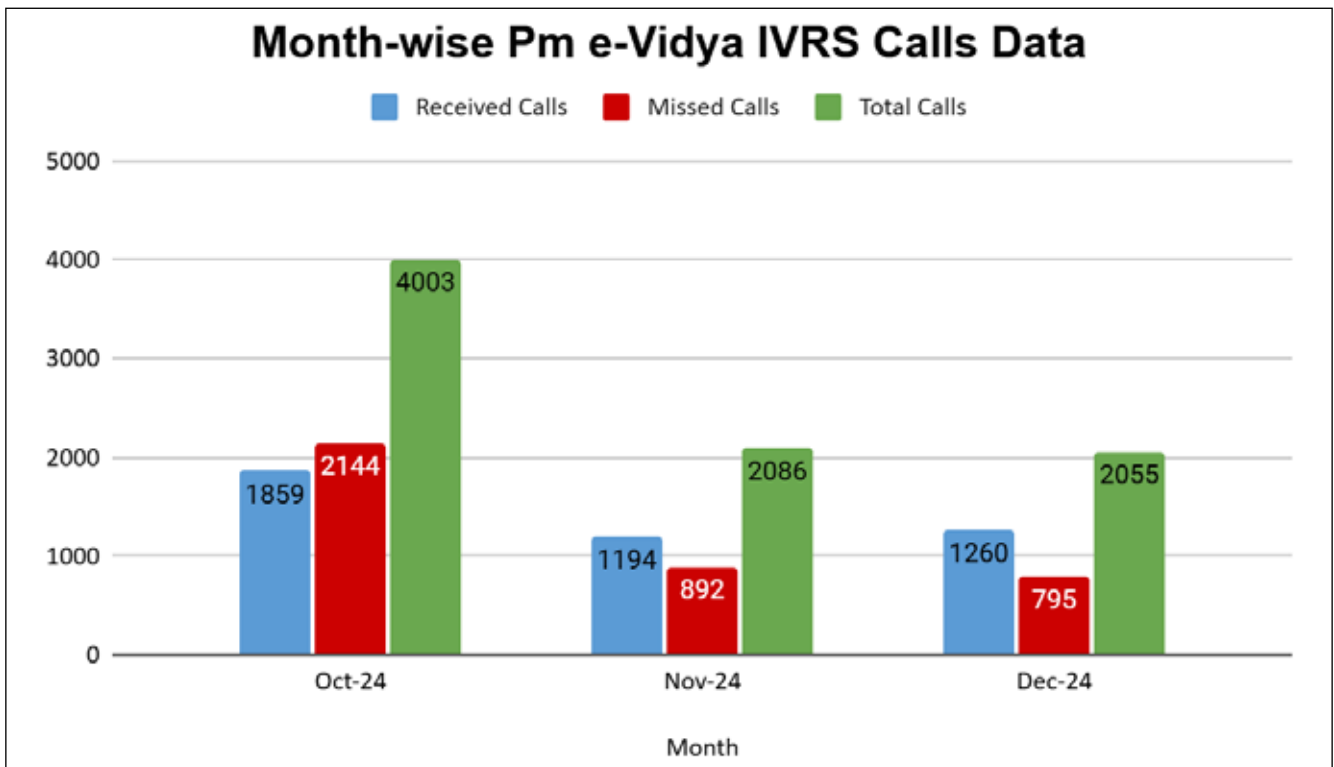

Figure-4 : Details of IVRS calls from States/UTs

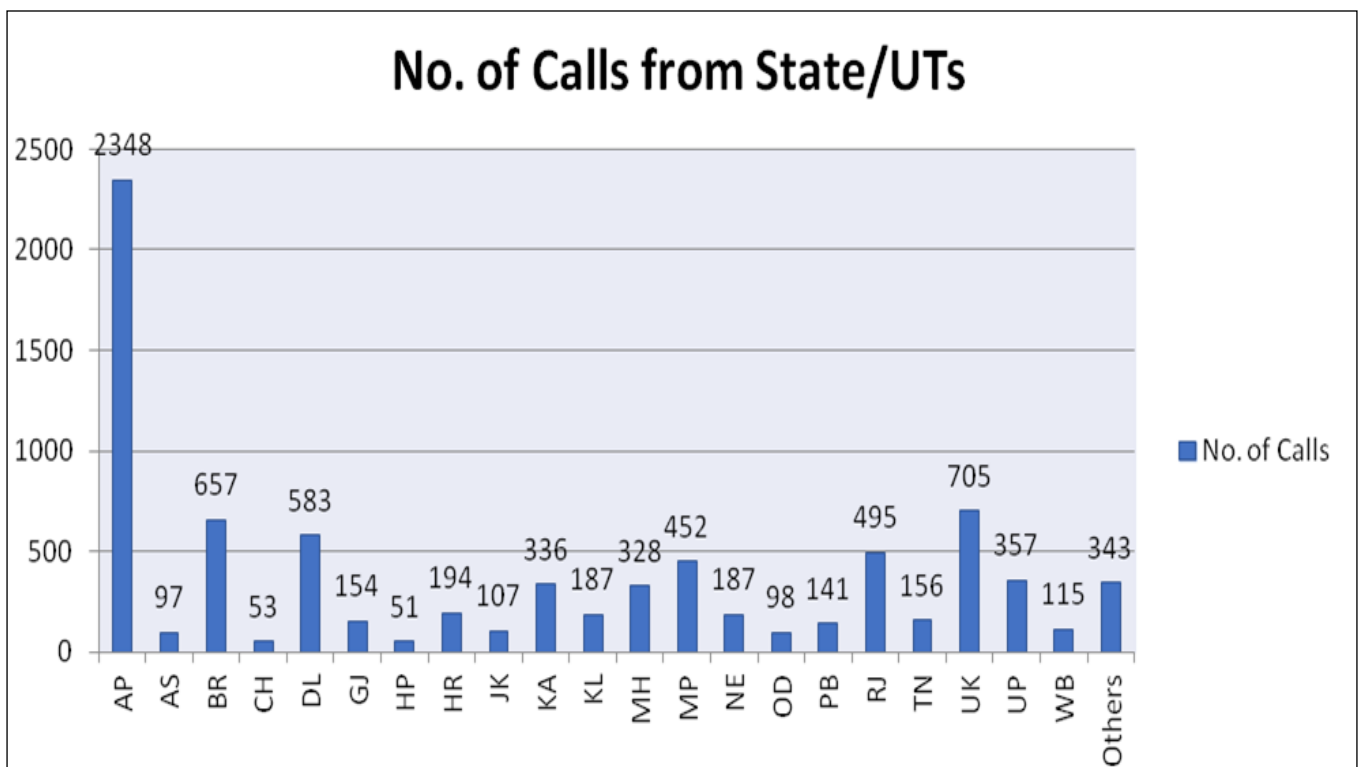
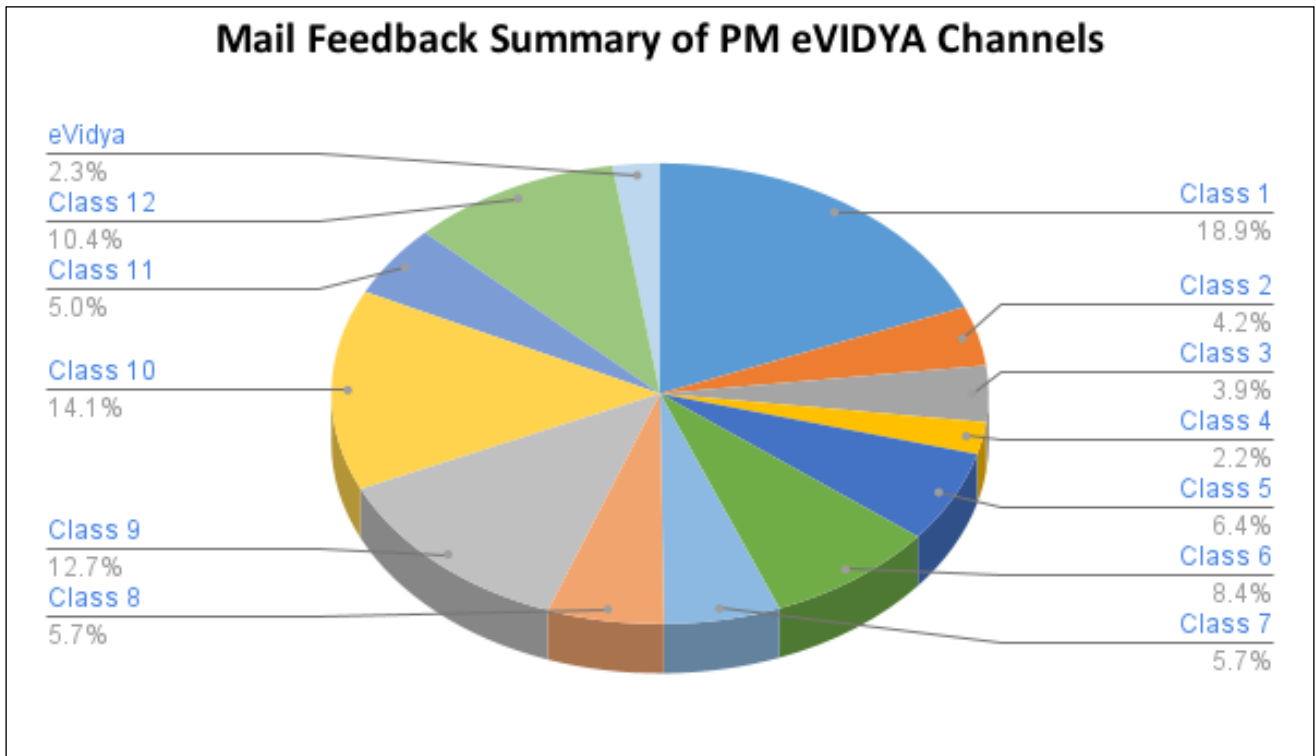


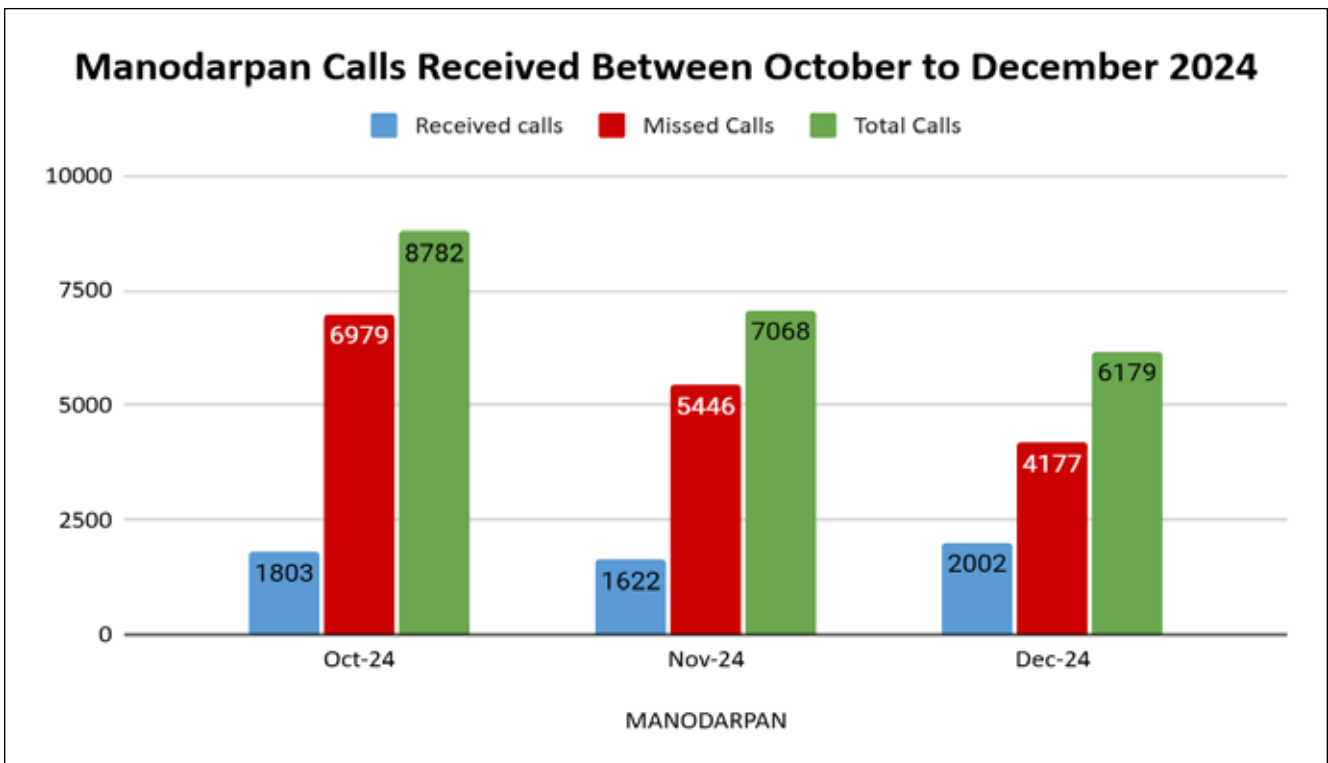
Figure 5 : Statewise calls received through PM eVIDYA IVR System (State/UTs/Capital as per Telecom Circles) during October - December 2024
