

Minutes of the 32nd Institute's Advisory Board (IAB) Meeting

The 32nd meeting of the Institute's Advisory Board (IAB) of CIET, NCERT was organized on 16th December, 2015 in room no. 229 at Chacha Nehru Bhawan, CIET. A list of members and invitees who participated in the meeting is attached at Annexure- I.

At the outset, Professor Rajaram S. Sharma, Joint Director, CIET, NCERT and Chairperson of the committee, extended a hearty welcome to the members and special invitees including CIET Faculty members and invited Professor A.P. Behera, Head, DICT and Training Division to make presentation on various activities of CIET. Professor Behera gave a brief account of the profile of Institute, major thrust of the Institute and new achievements of the institute including launch of e-pathshala mobile app, development of new interface of NROER, availability of ICT resources in 30 languages on NROER, formation of state core team on NROER, third party evaluation of 125 KVs and the submission of the report to KVs, development of M.Ed. and M.A Education course for e PG Pathshala and development of 65 MOOCs which would now be available on the new interface of NROER. He also gave the progress report of 2015-16 programmes along with the expenditure incurred on those and presented new programmes proposed for the year 2016-17. Play back of the launch video of e-pathshala App, new interface of NROER and glimpses of some audio-video programmes produced by CIET in the year 2015-16 was organized.

Since there were no comments and suggestions, minutes of the 31st meeting of the Institute's Advisory Board were confirmed. Joint Director, CIET then invited general comments, observations and suggestions. The members congratulated the Joint Director, CIET and the faculty of CIET for various activities and programs made by the institute with regard to the various programmes undertaken for the year 2015-16.

The following points emerged from the discussion.

- e-portfolio of ICT awardees should be made available to share the good practices they are involved in.
- A renewed focus of Director NCERT and MHRD on research should be taken note of and institute must take up more research based activities.
- The research should be focused on developing an insight as to where we stand and where we need to improve upon.
- The process of audio video programme production should head towards systematic identification of curricular themes and issues so that more theme and issue based programmes may be produced.

- During the development of educational media programmes, collaboration with other departments should also be planned.
- Some follow up activities should be devised so that the institute may know the impact of programmes and how the programmes are being used by the target groups.
- MOOCs will be launched on the new interface of NROER and should serve a two fold purpose (i) for students as self learning modules and (ii) for teachers as structured lesson plans to be used for teaching learning purposes. As a long term plan they may also result in to a certificate course.
- Apart from Hindi, English and Urdu, NCERT textbooks and material should be made available in all the languages listed in our constitution.
- There should be MOOCs on the different kits developed by NCERT.
- Whatever possible components of gender should be taken into account in CIET activities.
- An action taken report on the suggestions made by the members should accompanied with the minutes of the meeting.

Then detailed programme proposals planned for execution during the year 2016-17 were presented. The proposal-wise comments, suggestions on IAB programmes for 2016-17 along with their recommendations and remarks of the committee are given as under:
