Minutes of the 33rd Institute's Advisory Board (IAB) Meeting

The 33rd meeting of the Institute's Advisory Board (IAB) of CIET, NCERT was organized on 5thJanuary, 2017 in room no. 229 at Chacha Nehru Bhawan, CIET. A list of members and invitees who participated in the meeting is attached at Annexure- I.

At the outset, Professor Rajaram S. Sharma, Joint Director, CIET, NCERT and Chairperson of the committee, extended a hearty welcome to the members and special invitees including CIET Faculty members and invited Professor A.P. Behera, Head, DICT and Training Division to make presentation on various activities of CIET. Professor Behera gave a brief account of the profile of Institute, major thrust of the Institute and new achievements of the institute including development of school level courses for the SWAYAM platform for offering Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs), telecast of Educational programs for Secondary and Senior Secondary level under Swayam Prabha project a 24X7 DTH Channel was discussed along with the upcoming revival of telecast from FM Gyan Vani and Gyan Darshan Channels. ICT curriculum for Teacher Education, role of NCERT as National MOOCs Coordinator (NMC) for School level MOOCs and launch of School MOOCs in 12 subjects to start with for Senior secondary level, the progress of e-pathshala website and mobile app launched in the previous year and development of the second version of this App with content mapping, development of new interface of NROER, availability of ICT resources in 29 languages on NROER, formation of state core teams on NROER, development of M.Ed. and M.A Education course contents for ePG Pathshala to be hosted on SWAYAM by UGC. Implementation of GEQAF in collaboration with UNESCO and organisation of International ICT Forum in CIET where participants from 14 countries took part, the eLibrary project for Bhutan where CIET-NCERT is developing an online library in collaboration with CDAC was also discussed. He also gave the progress report of 2016-17 programmes along with the expenditure incurred on those and presented new programmes proposed for the year 2017-18.

Since there were no comments and suggestions, minutes of the 32ndmeeting of the Institute's Advisory Board were confirmed. Joint Director, CIET then invited general comments, observations and suggestions. The members congratulated the Joint Director, CIET and the faculty of CIET for various activities and programs made by the institute under various programmes undertaken for the year 2016-17.

The following points emerged from the discussion.

- Programs useful for everyone should be produced which should cater to the needs of SC, ST and girls education also.
- Trainings fulfilling the needs of people from North-Eastern region should be planned in consultation with the members of that region.
- Development of criteria for assessing the gaps must be done for planning training programs and developing programs.
- The innovative work done by teachers from other institutions like, NVS, KVS, etc. should also be shared with public along with the ICT Awardees work.
- The programs catering to the needs of children with special needs should be developed.
- E-content should be developed extensively with the use of Open Source software.
- Utilisation of services of ICT Awardees should be done in a better way for more activities.
- Research should be focused on impact and utilization of MOOCs and other initiatives of ICT.
- The process of audio video programme production should head towards systematic identification of curricular themes and issues so that more theme and issue based can be comprehensively covered.
- Some follow up activities should be devised so that the institute may know the impact of programmes and how the programmes are being used by the target groups.

The programme proposals planned for execution during the year 2017-18 were presented. The proposal-wise comments, suggestions on IAB programmes for 2017-18 along with their recommendations and remarks of the committee are given as under:
